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As Reminder to Always Follow P.A.W.S., Teachers will Support Students and Work with Parents

First Offense: Teacher will discuss and remind student of correct P.A.W.S. behavior and contact parents.

Second Offense: Teacher will contact parents and follow-up to make sure P.A.W.S. is followed at school and home. Teacher will let parents know about future consequences if the behavior persists.

Third Offense or When Appropriate: Teacher will fill out an Incident Report being sure to contact all necessary adults including parents.
