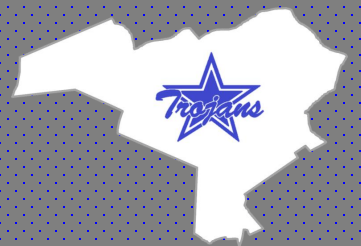


SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOALS

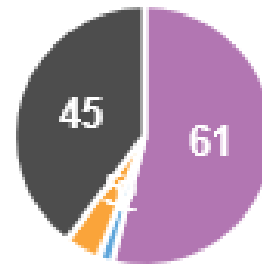
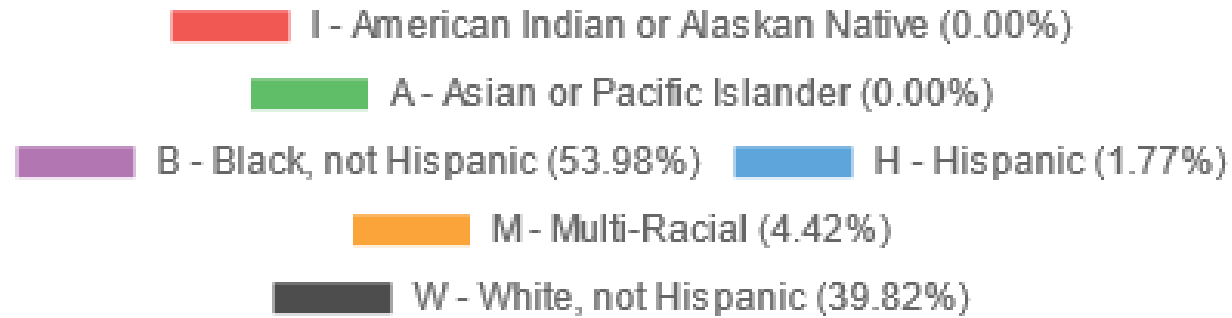

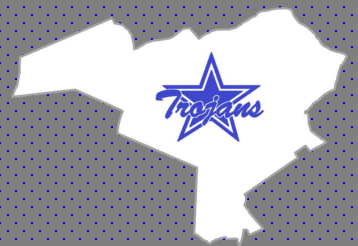


REFERRALS BY RACE (FY24)

2024 Johnson County Middle School



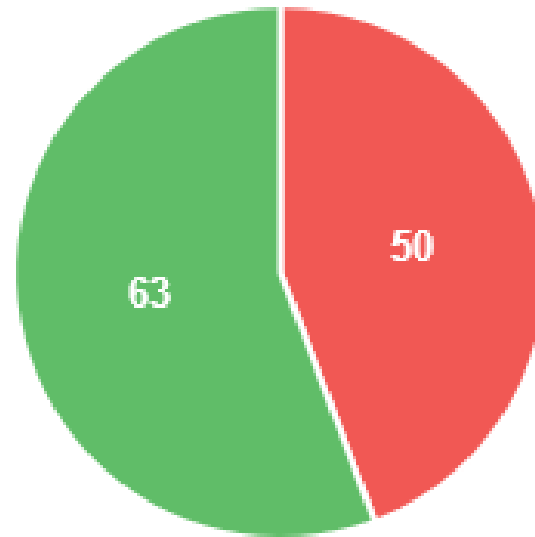

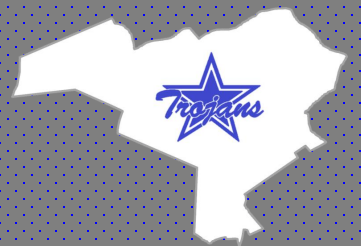
REFERRALS BY GENDER (FY24)
