


New York State's Graduation Measures Initiative

- The commission drafted a recommendation for a portrait of a graduate.
- They also proposed recommendations
 - Specific diploma credit requirements.
 - Greater access to Career and Technical Education.
 - Replace three diploma types with one diploma.




Greater Access to Career and Technical Education (CTE)

- CTE is one potential seal or endorsement students can earn with their diploma.
- Syosset has several pioneering pathways already in place for CTE.




Consolidating to One Diploma Type

- Currently there are three different diploma types students can earn
 - Regents Diploma with Advanced Designation
 - Regents Diploma
 - Local Diploma
- The commission has recommended that these diploma types be consolidated into one diploma type with an emphasis on different pathways.



Seal of Civic Readiness

- Students demonstrate understanding of government, civic responsibility and civic values.
- Places an emphasis on civic engagement and scholarship.
- Student earn points through coursework and a capstone project.



Individual Arts Assessment Pathway


- Students complete three a three-unit sequence in the arts.
- Students demonstrate growth through a collection of creative works that meet indicators defined by the New York State Learning Standards for the Arts.
- The specific artistic methods, forms or media students use to meet the criteria are based on individual students' artistic interests




Career and Technical Education (CTE) Pathway

- Students complete a NYSED-approved Career and Technical Education Program
- Earn a passing score on a 3-part technical assessment.
- Students earn micro-credentials along the way.
