Woodbury School Potential Uses


- Small Pre-k program
 - Would be aidable for construction
 - Gym would be used for PE, OT and PT services, etc.
 - The pre-K program could be targeted to service a more special needs population.
- Adult education
 - The Gym could be a multi-use space after hours for adult education (also building aidable).
- Staff professional development.
 - Using the gym as a multi-use space, it could serve as a conference area for staff training during the day when not needed for Pre-K gym/OT/PT.
- Community Center
 - The conference room/gym space might also be useful for community groups seeking to host after-hours meetings (homeowner associations, etc.).
- Business Office Space
 - We would relocate offices from South Woods to free up classroom space for growth.
