Greater-Southern Tier BOCES Vocational Education

Class Rank

Class rank is determined by the cumulative average for all credit bearing courses and includes final numerical grades. Non-Regents final course grades will be multiplied by a factor of 1.00. Regents final course grades will be multiplied by a factor of 1.01. ACE, AP, and College (taught by JTCSD Faculty) final course grades will be multiplied by a factor of 1.05. The enhanced averages will determine a final weighted rank.
