Dear Families:

Students in grades 3-5 will be taking the New York State English Language Arts (ELA) Assessment and the New York State Mathematics Assessment shortly. 4th graders will also take the NYS Science Assessment. In the event that your child is ill on testing days, there will be an assessment make-up day. If your child will be absent, please remember to call the automated attendance line at 209-6279 (press *) to report the absence.

As in the past, each assessment will be given over two days for a total of four days of assessment for ELA and Math. The assessments are untimed allowing all students to complete each session at their own pace.

The schedule is as follows:

English Language Arts Assessment (2 sessions) Dates: Tuesday, March 29th - Wednesday, March 30th

Make-up Dates: Thursday, March 31* - Friday, April 8th

Mathematics Assessment (2 sessions)

Dates: Tuesday, April 26th - Wednesday, April 27th Make-up Dates: Thursday, April 28th - Monday, May 9th

4th Grade Science Assessment (2 sessions)

Written Test: Monday, June 6th (Make-up Dates: Tuesday, June 7th - Friday, June 10th) Performance Test: Tuesday, May 24th - Friday, June 3rd (Windom will select two days within this window)

These assessments will be given during the morning of the designated testing days. Please make every effort to make sure that your child is here on time for the assessments. We are unable to administer the assessments outside of the make-up windows.

If you have any questions about the assessments, I would be happy to discuss them with you. I encourage you to go to engageNY.org for more information. This web page has a section for parents and guardians that is very helpful. There are also sample questions for the ELA and Mathematics assessments on the website.


