

CDEP Goal 2012-15

• Goal:

• "Use resources to create a comprehensive plan to ensure the physical and social well-being of staff and students."

Activity:

- "Implement the Olweus Program with fidelity."
- "Assess student perceptions every other year to measure reduction in bullying behaviors."

• Leaders:

- District trainers
- BPCC members





CDEP Goal

- Timeline: 2012-15
- Professional Development:
 - "On-going training of new staff including bus drivers, cafeteria staff, SRPs, teachers, coaches and administrators."
 - "Continue to educate parents and the community to raise awareness and support for the tenets of the program."
- Cost:
 - Student Questionnaire: \$5,500.
 - Additional trainer: \$6,000.




Olweus Student Questionnaire data compared for each Orchard Park school


























































South Davis - % of students whose teacher, or another teacher, has talked with them once or more in the past couple of months about bullying other students























Windom - % of students whose teacher, or another teacher, has talked with them once or more in the past couple of months about bullying other students

















OPMS - % of students whose teacher, or another teacher, has talked with them once or more in the past couple of months about bullying other students















































How often are you afraid of being bullied by other students? (sometimes, fairly often, often or very often)














OPCSD teachers are more proactive than the national figures in asking students about bullying.
















- BPCCs will analyze the 2016 questionnaire results

Orchard Park CSD as a model in Western New York

- Olweus implemented district-wide in Sept. 2010
 - Since then, our trainers:
 - Have trained 400+ educators at the WNY Character Council 2011-12 spring and fall conferences
 - Trained two other schools in the Olweus Bullying Prevention Program (Tonawanda City, Nativity, and Cassadaga Valley)
 - Consulted with 6 other public schools, 1 charter school, and 2 private schools considering this program
 - Continue to train community members: OPPD, YMCA, OP Town Rec, WNY Recreation Department Directors' Association
