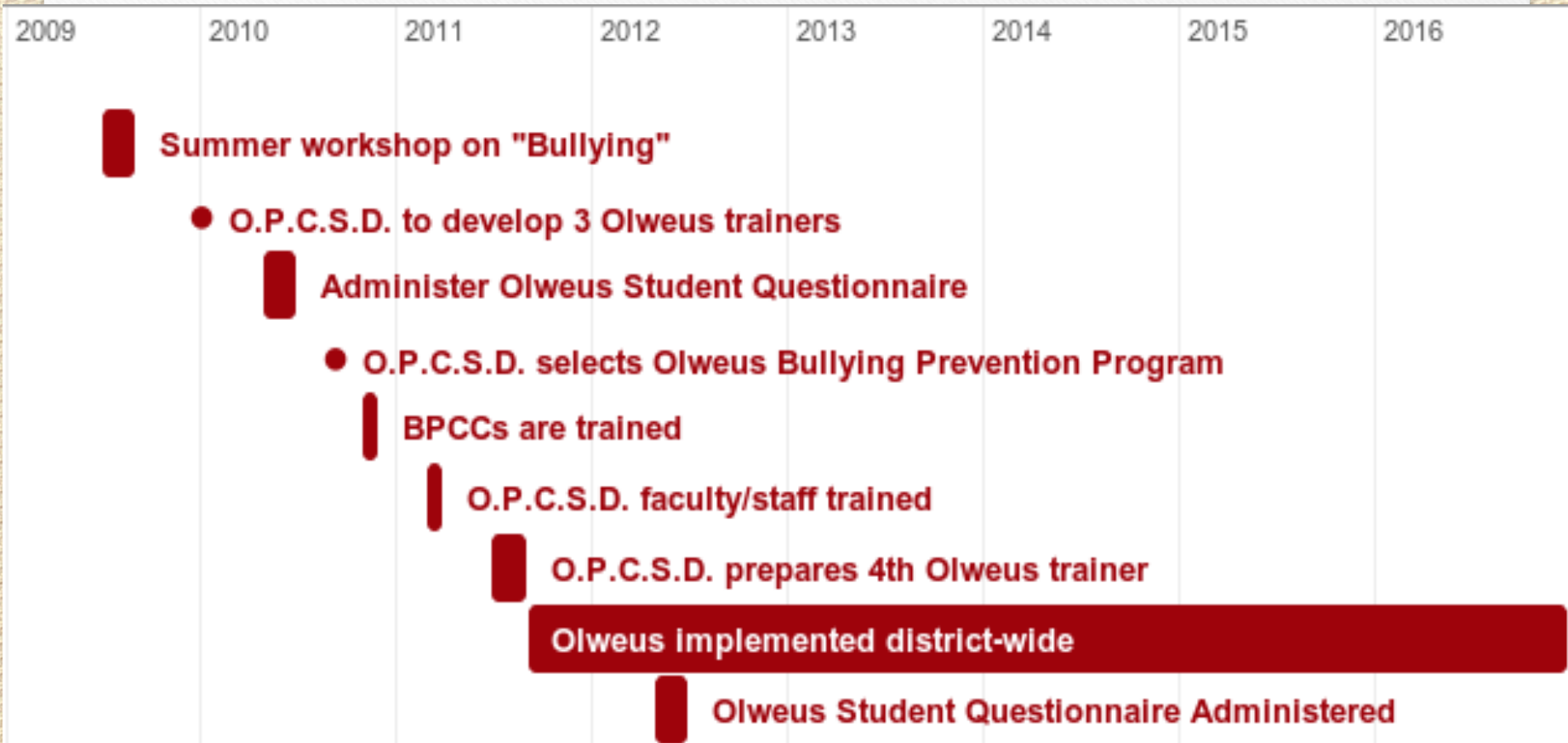

Original Timeline



CDEP Goal 2012-15

- Goal:

 - “Use resources to create a comprehensive plan to ensure the physical and social well-being of staff and students.”
- Activity:
 - “Implement the Olweus Program with fidelity.”
 - “Assess student perceptions every other year to measure reduction in bullying behaviors.”
- Leaders:
 - District trainers
 - BPCC members

CDEP Goal

- Timeline: 2012-15
- Professional Development:
 - “On-going training of new staff including bus drivers, cafeteria staff, SRPs, teachers, coaches and administrators.”
 - “Continue to educate parents and the community to raise awareness and support for the tenets of the program.”
- Cost:
 - Student Questionnaire: \$5,500.
 - Additional trainer: \$6,000.

2014

- OPSCD prepares 4th Olweus trainer
- Olweus Student Questionnaire Administered
- OPCSD launches “Peaceful School Bus” in elementary schools

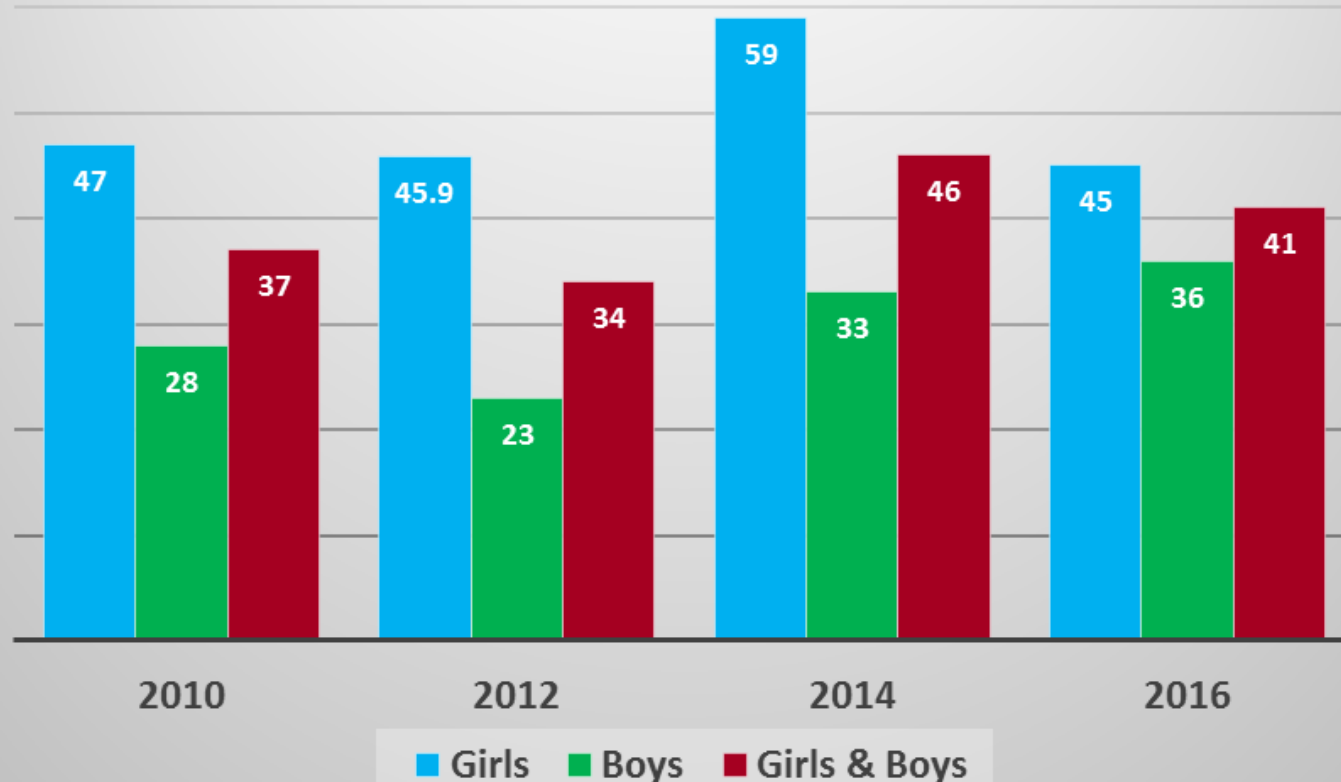

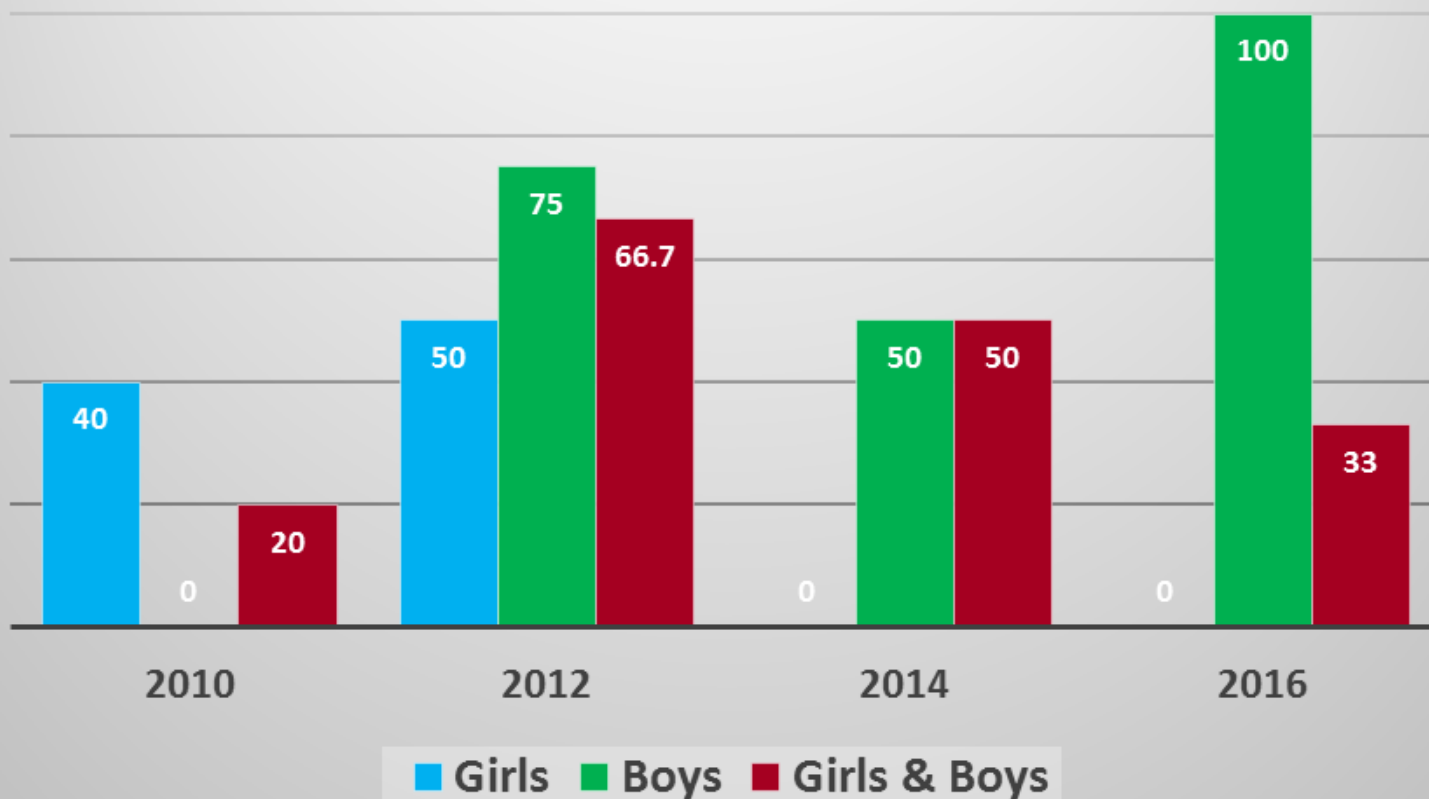

Eggert - How often are you afraid of being bullied by other students? (sometimes, fairly often, often or very often)



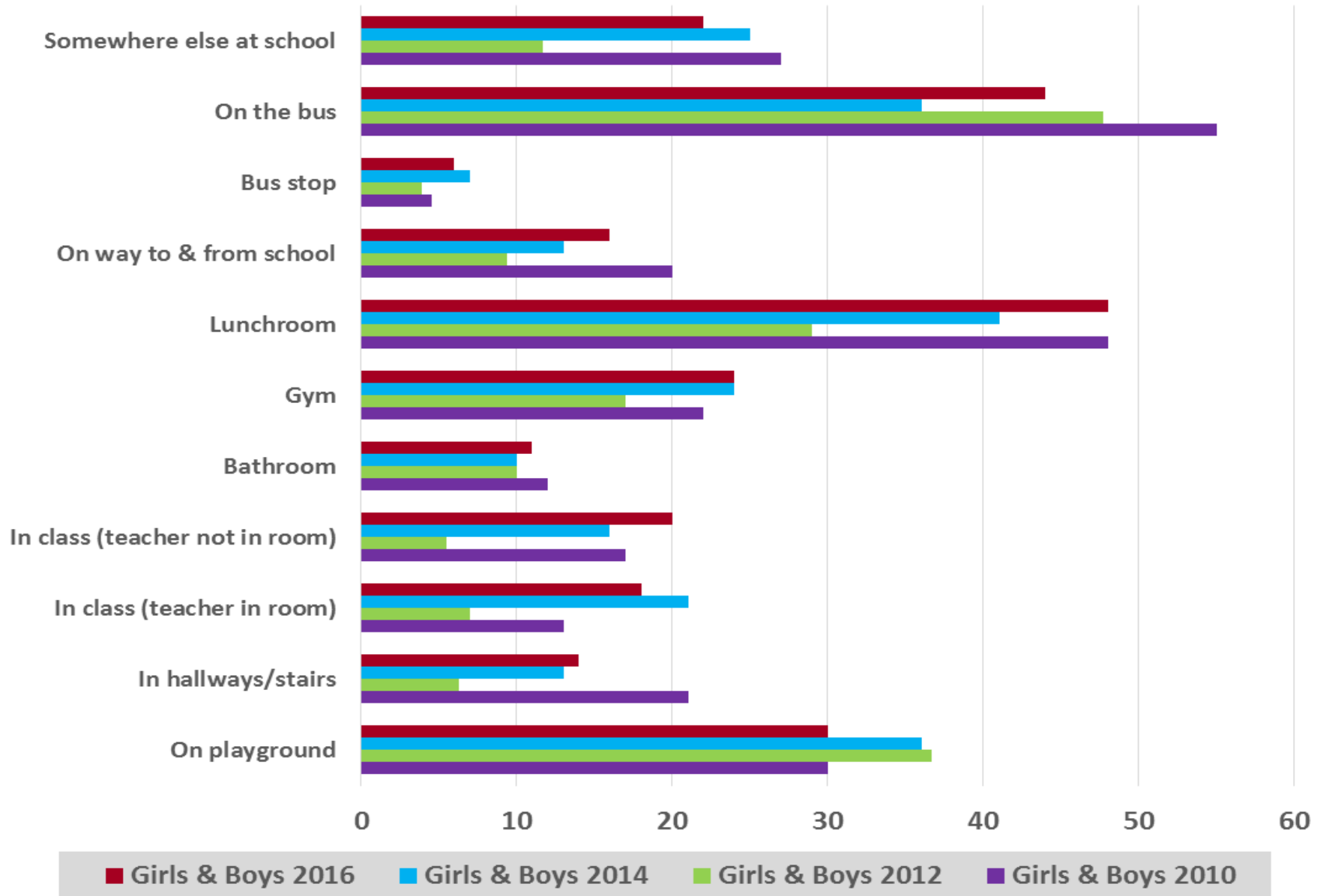
2016: n= 251 students (118 girls; 133 boys)

Eggert - % of students whose teacher, or another teacher, has talked with them once or more in the past couple of months about bullying other students



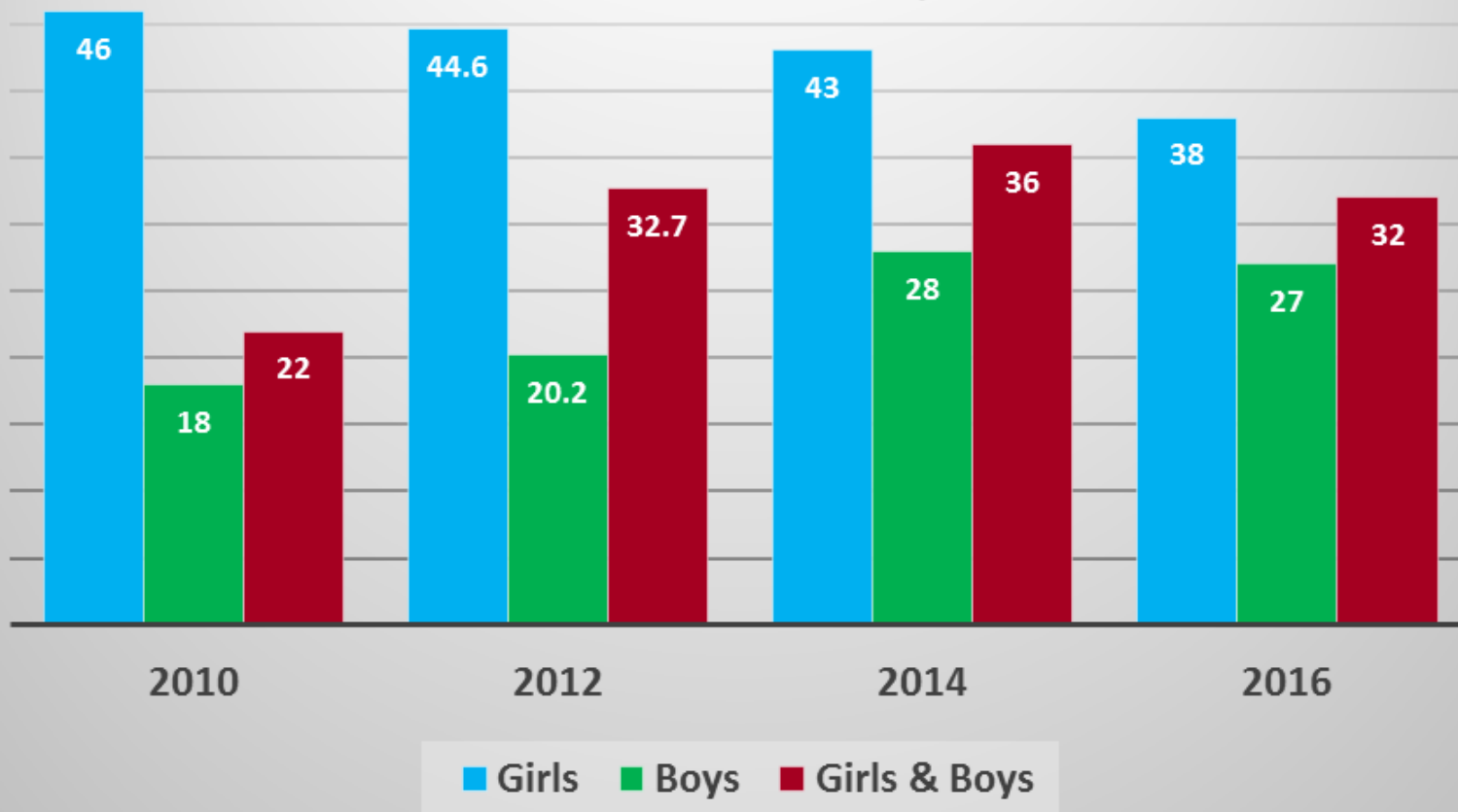
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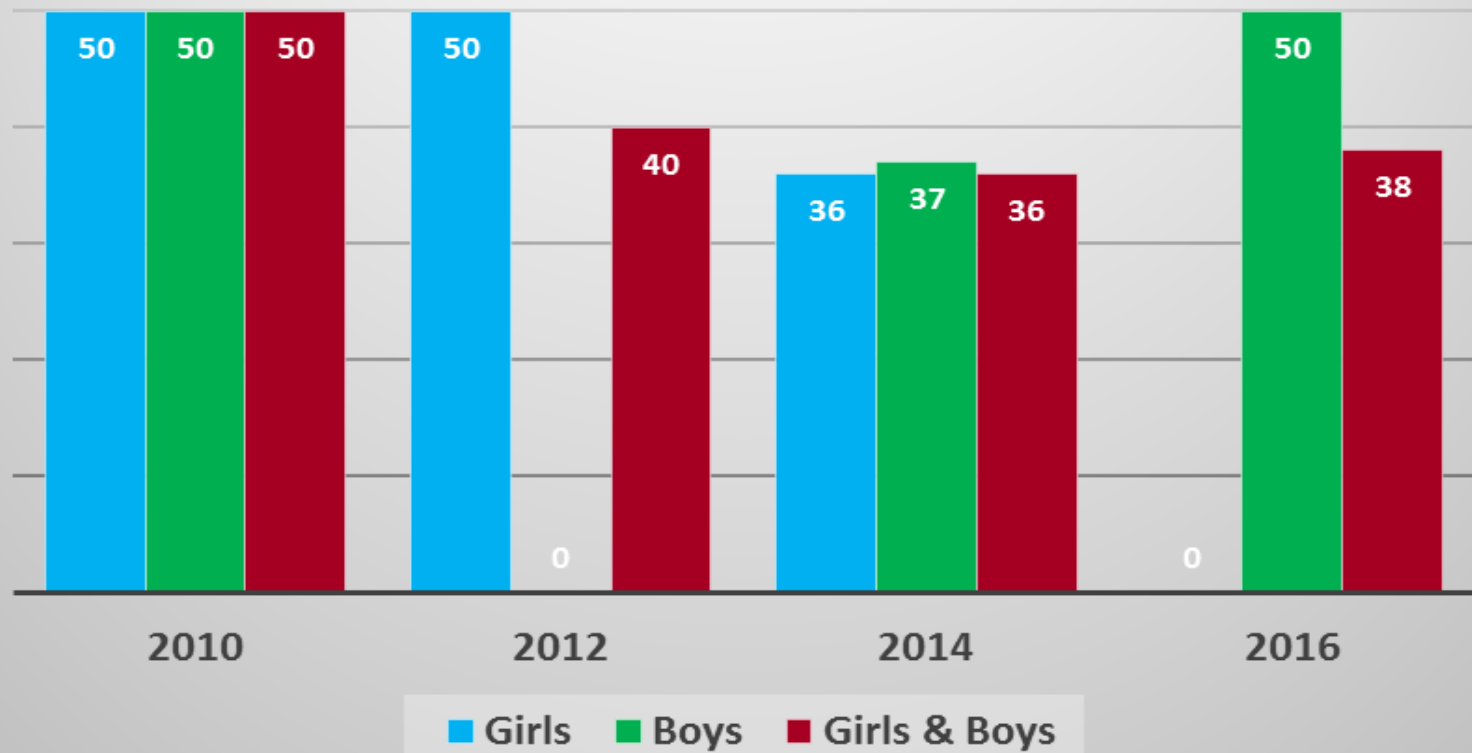
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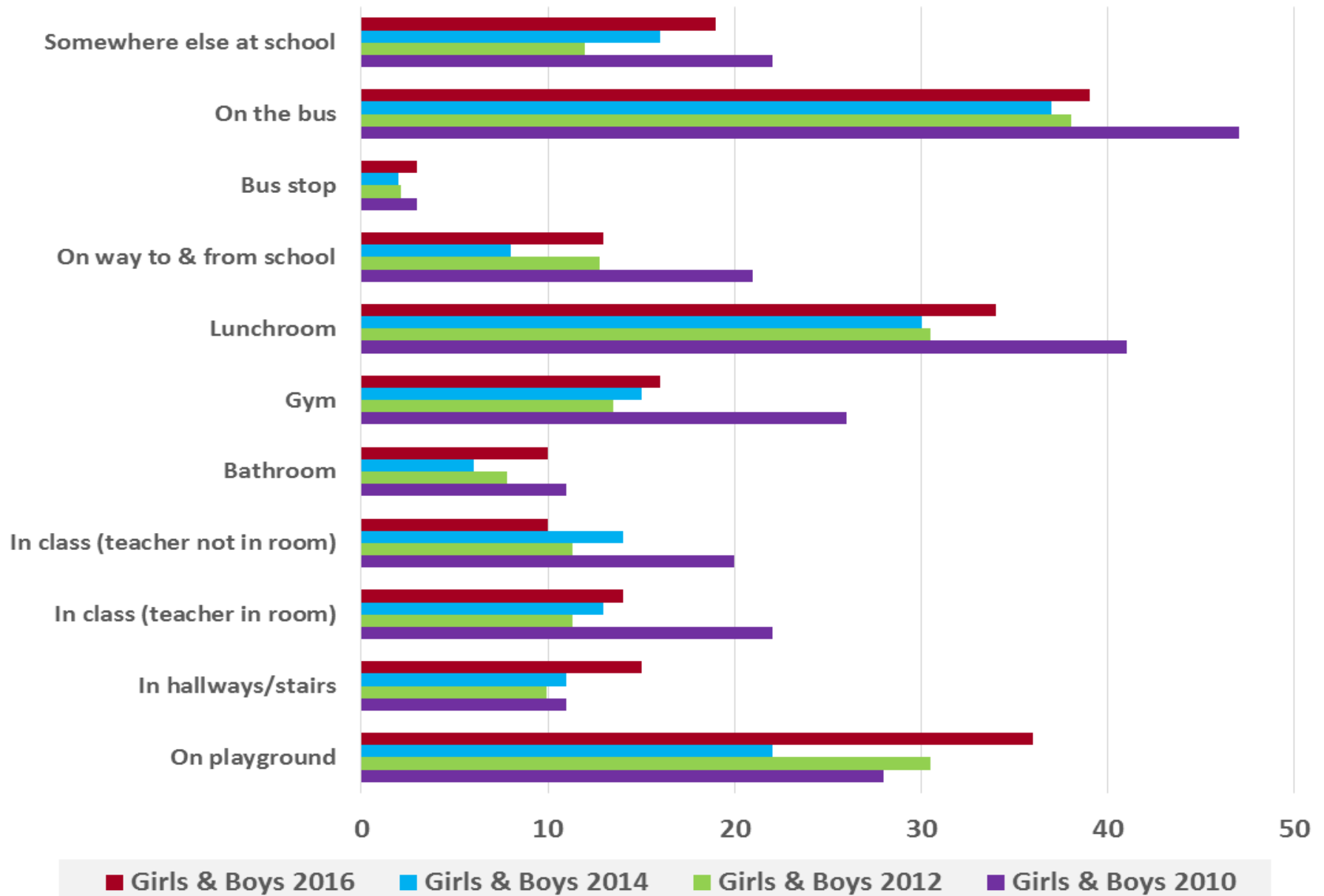
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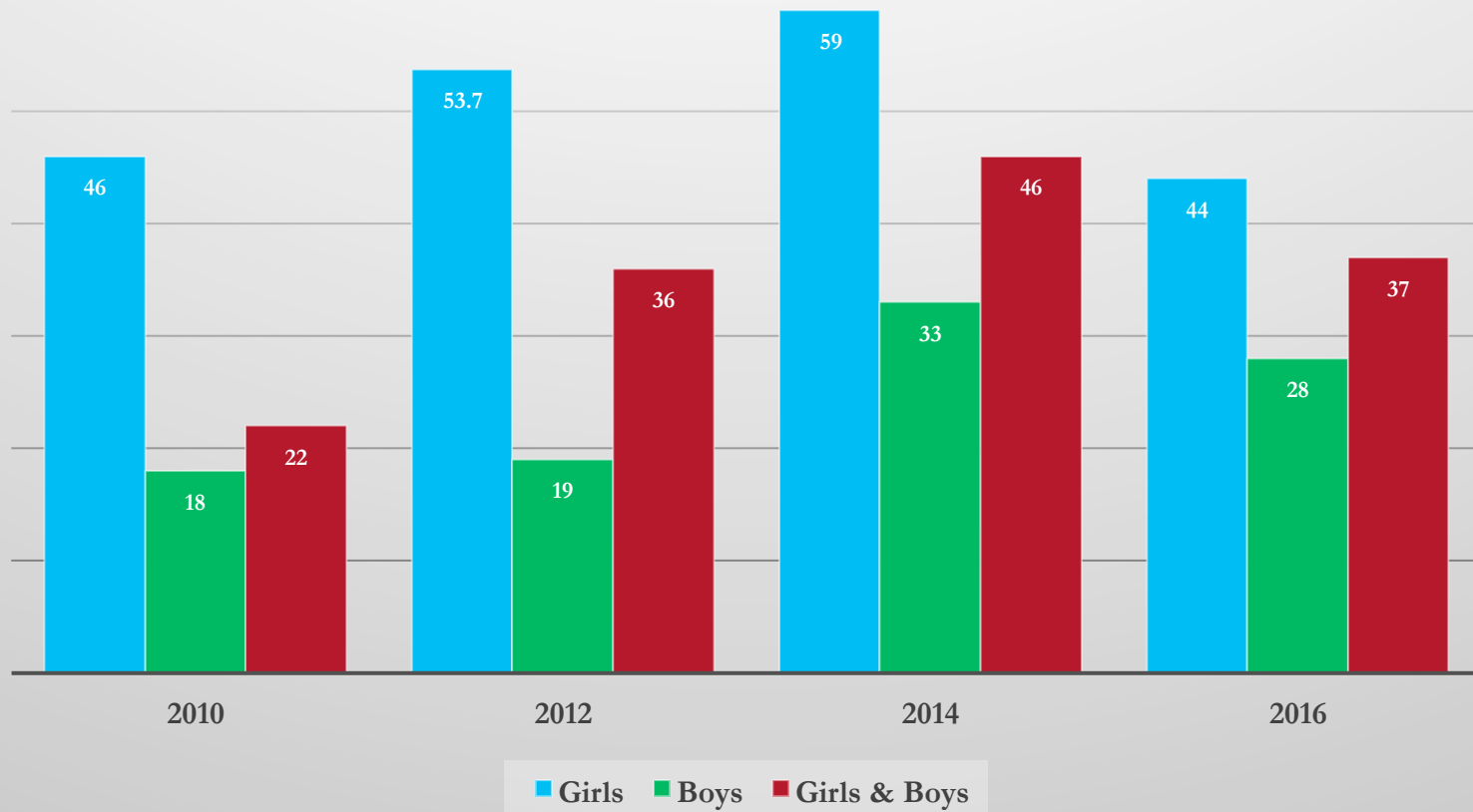
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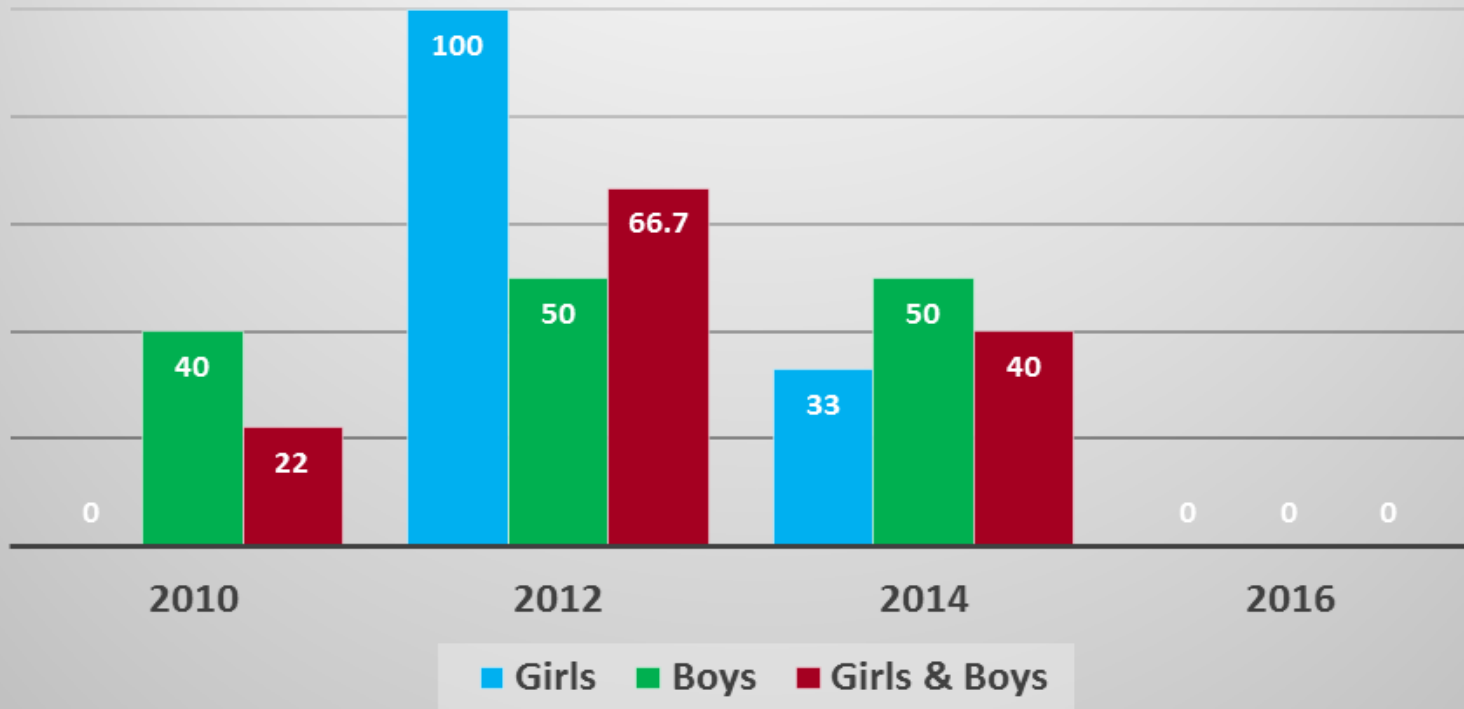
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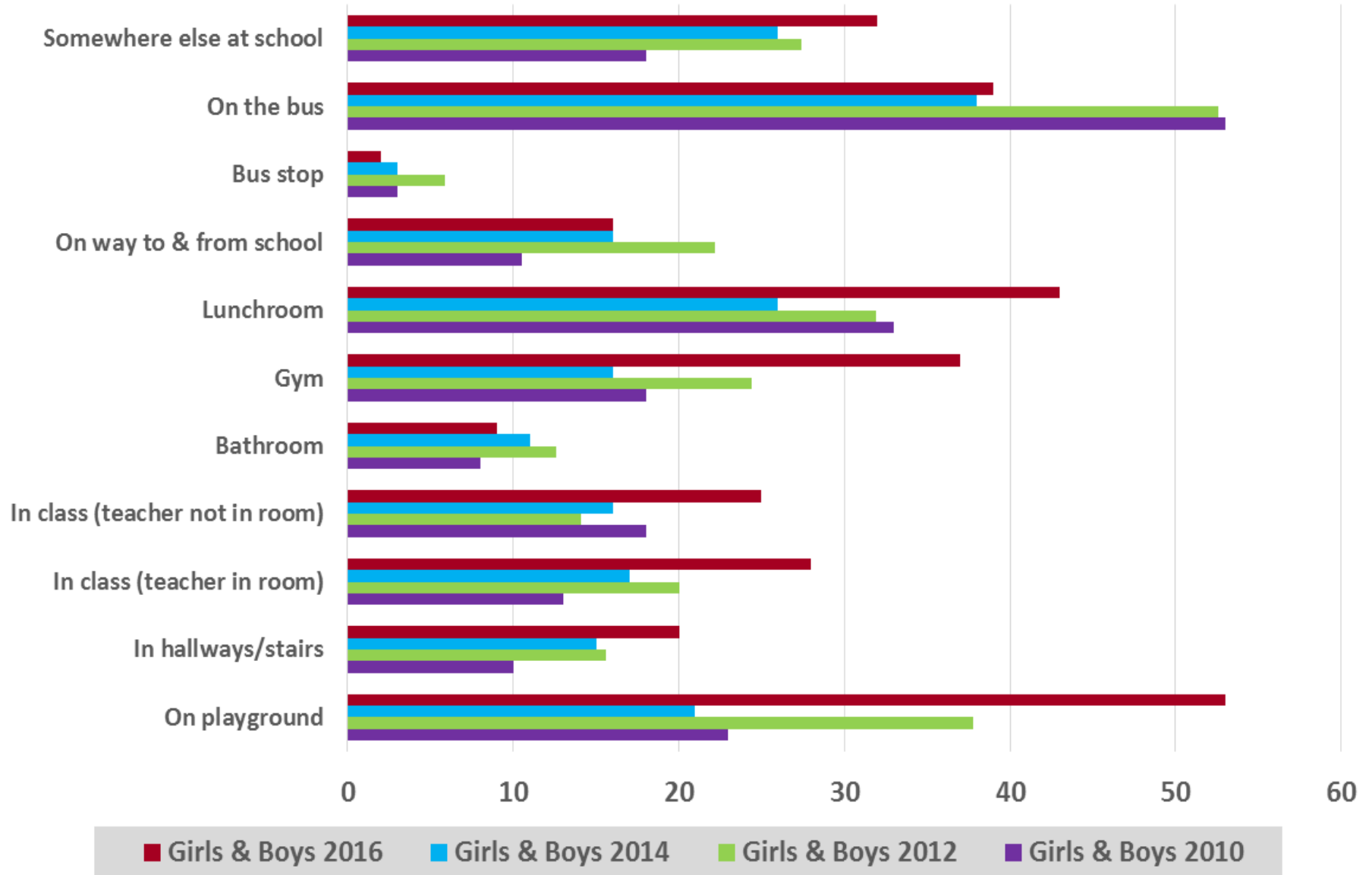
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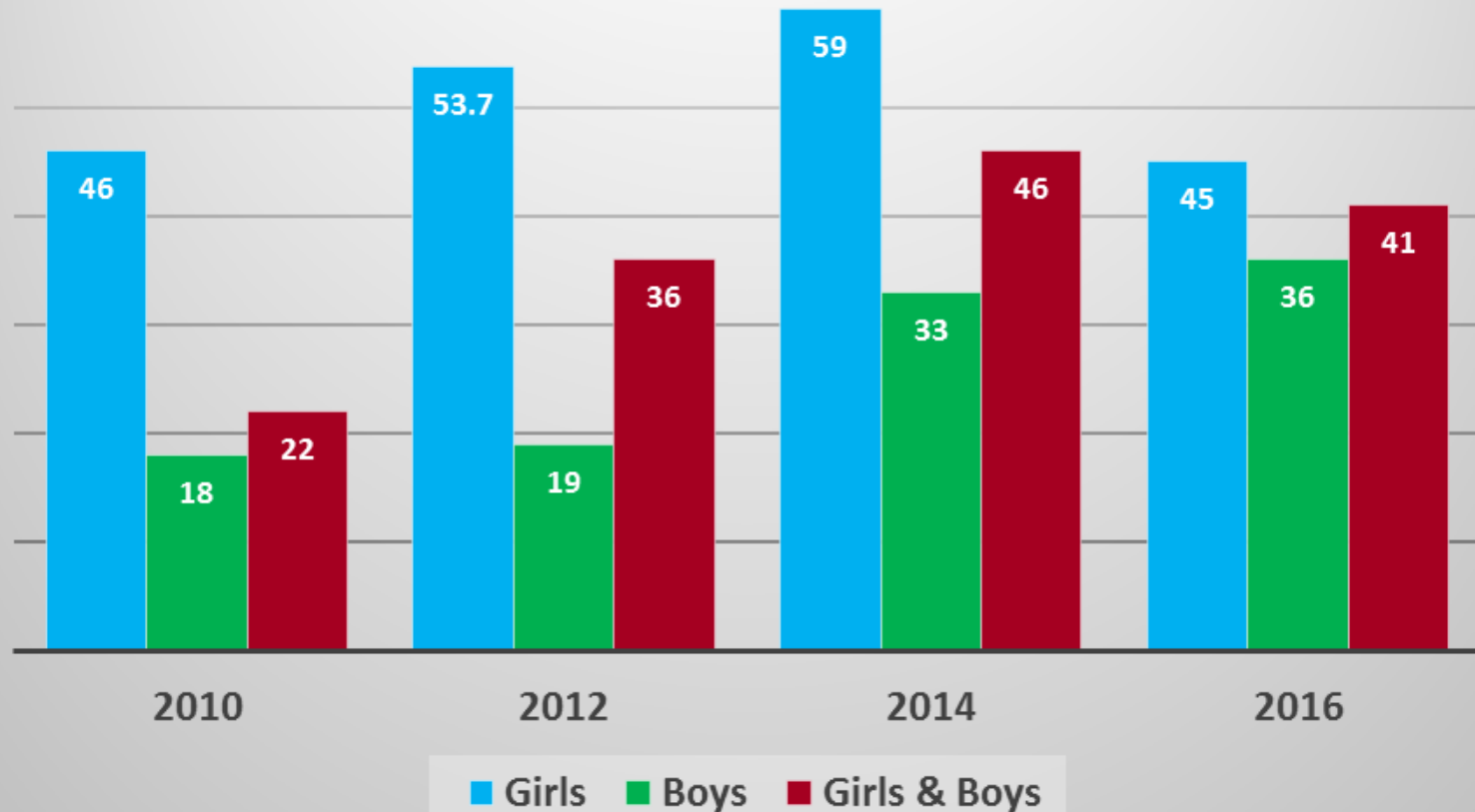
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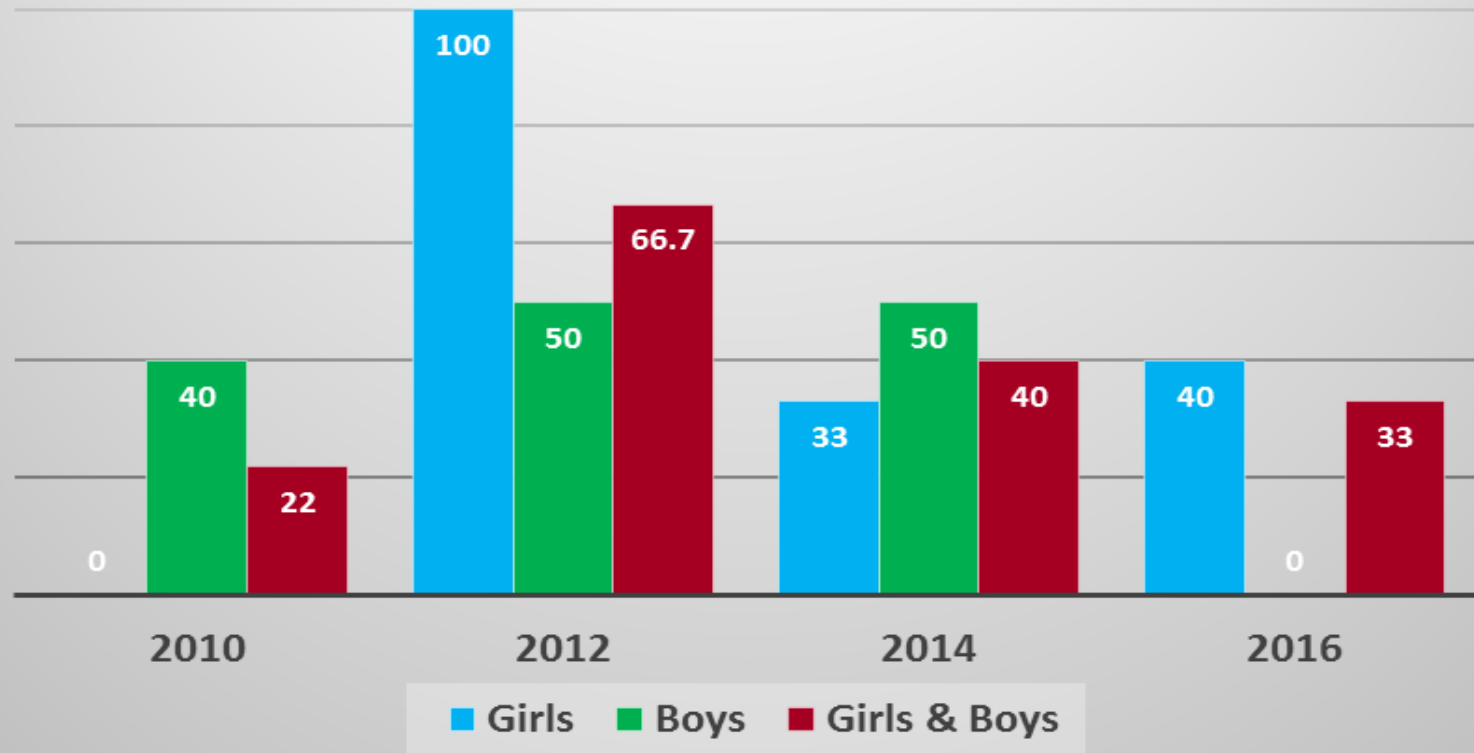
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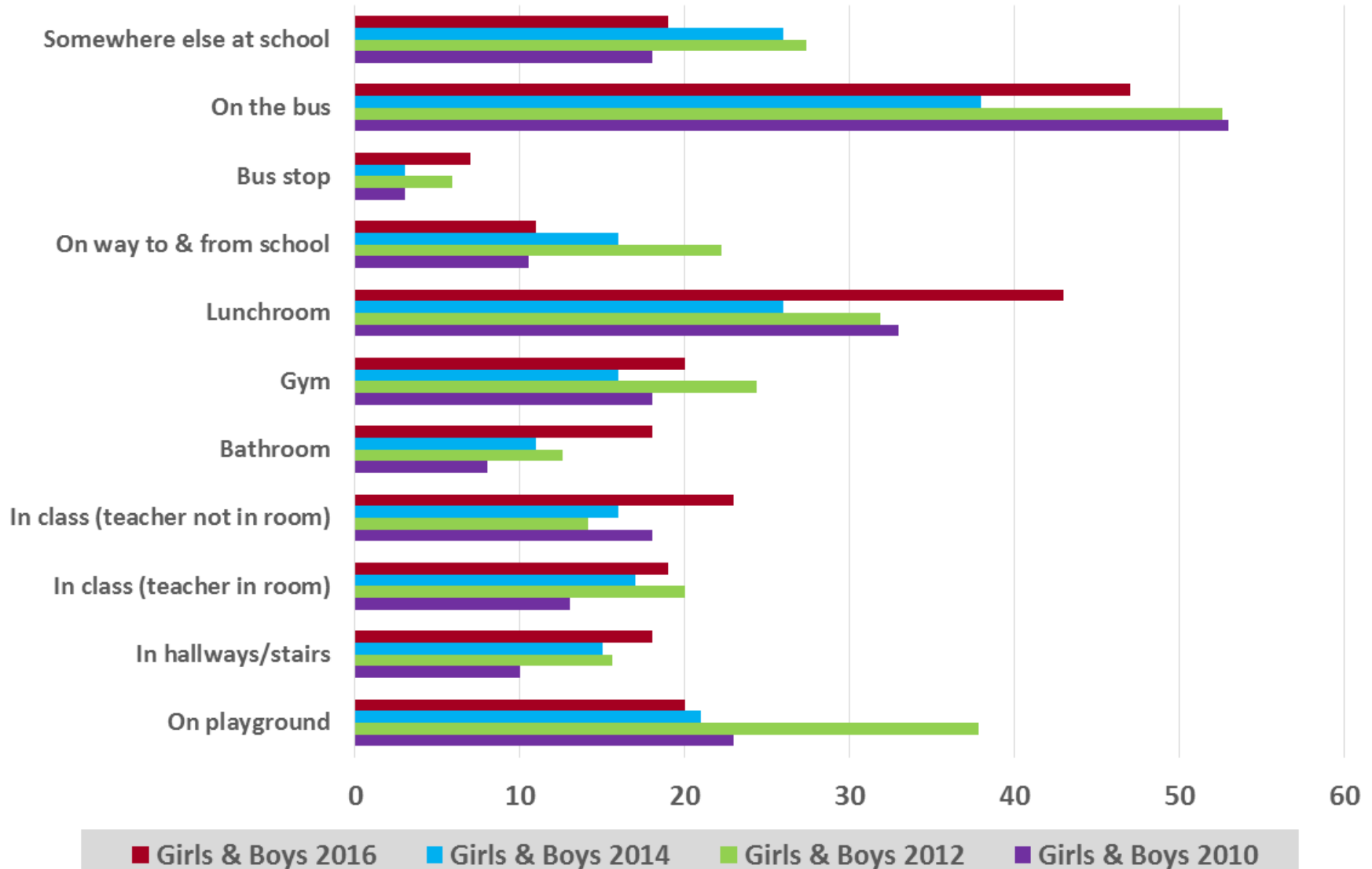

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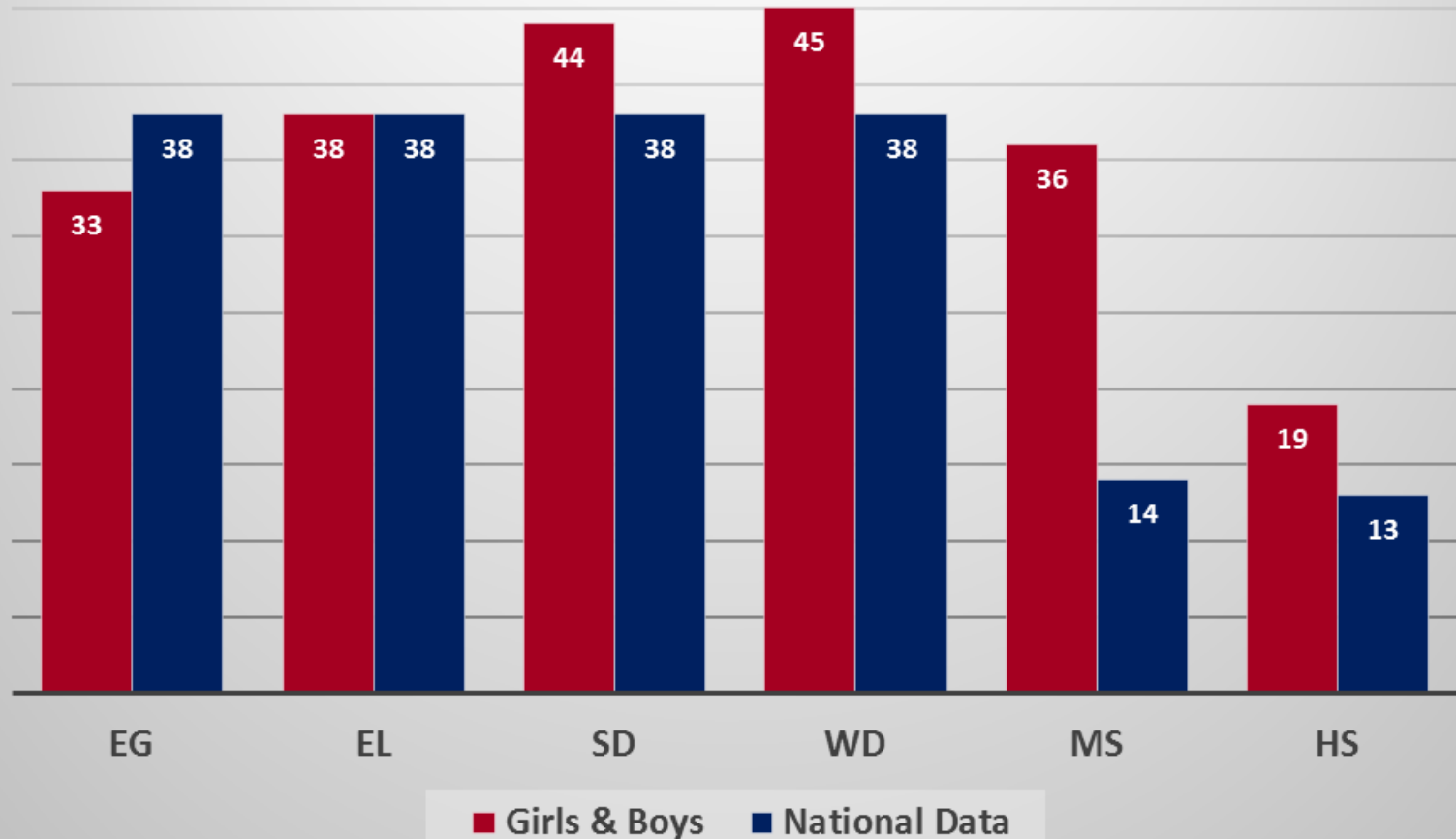


ALL Schools Trend - How often are you afraid of being bullied by other students.

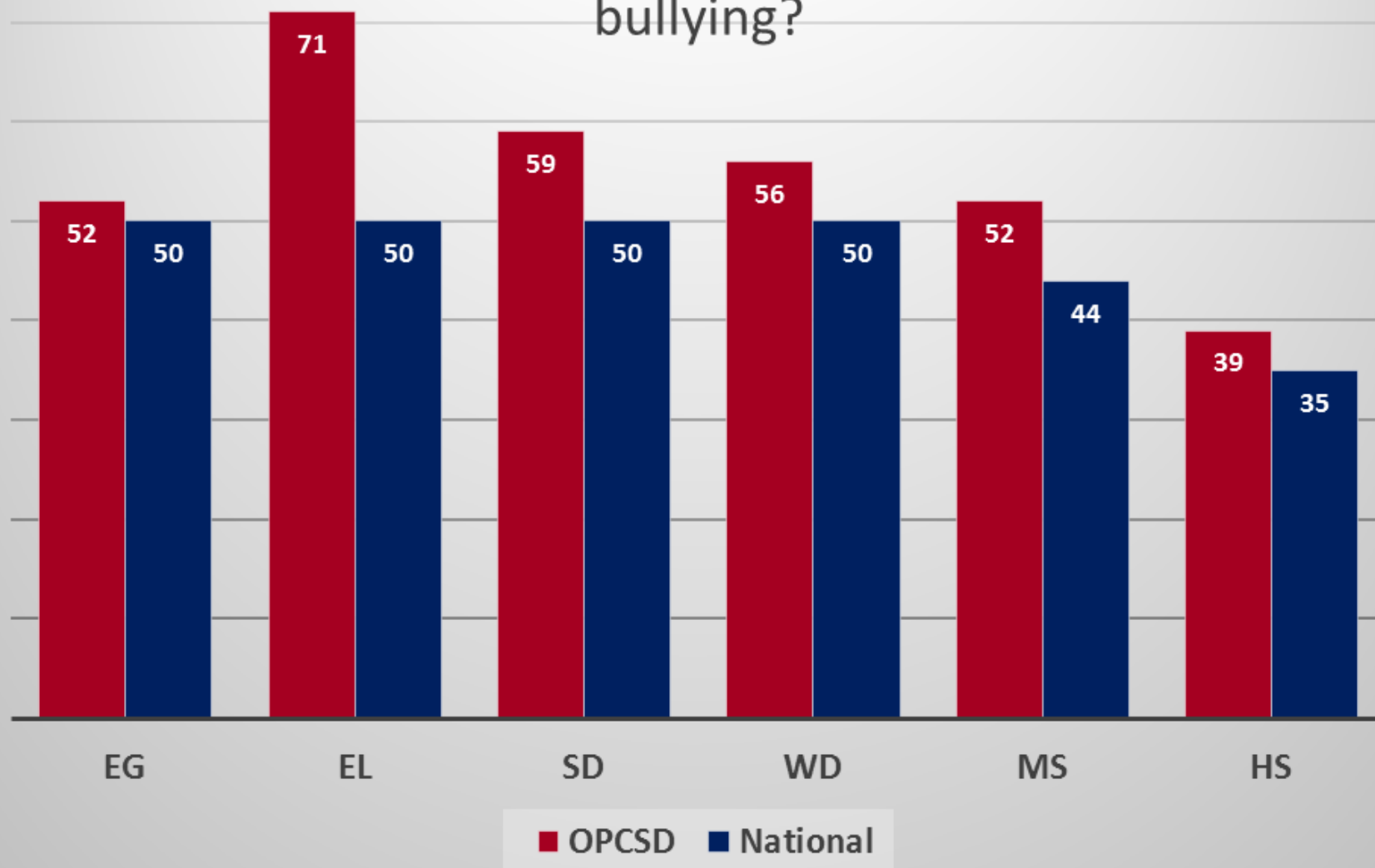


OPCSD teachers are more proactive than the national figures in asking students about bullying.

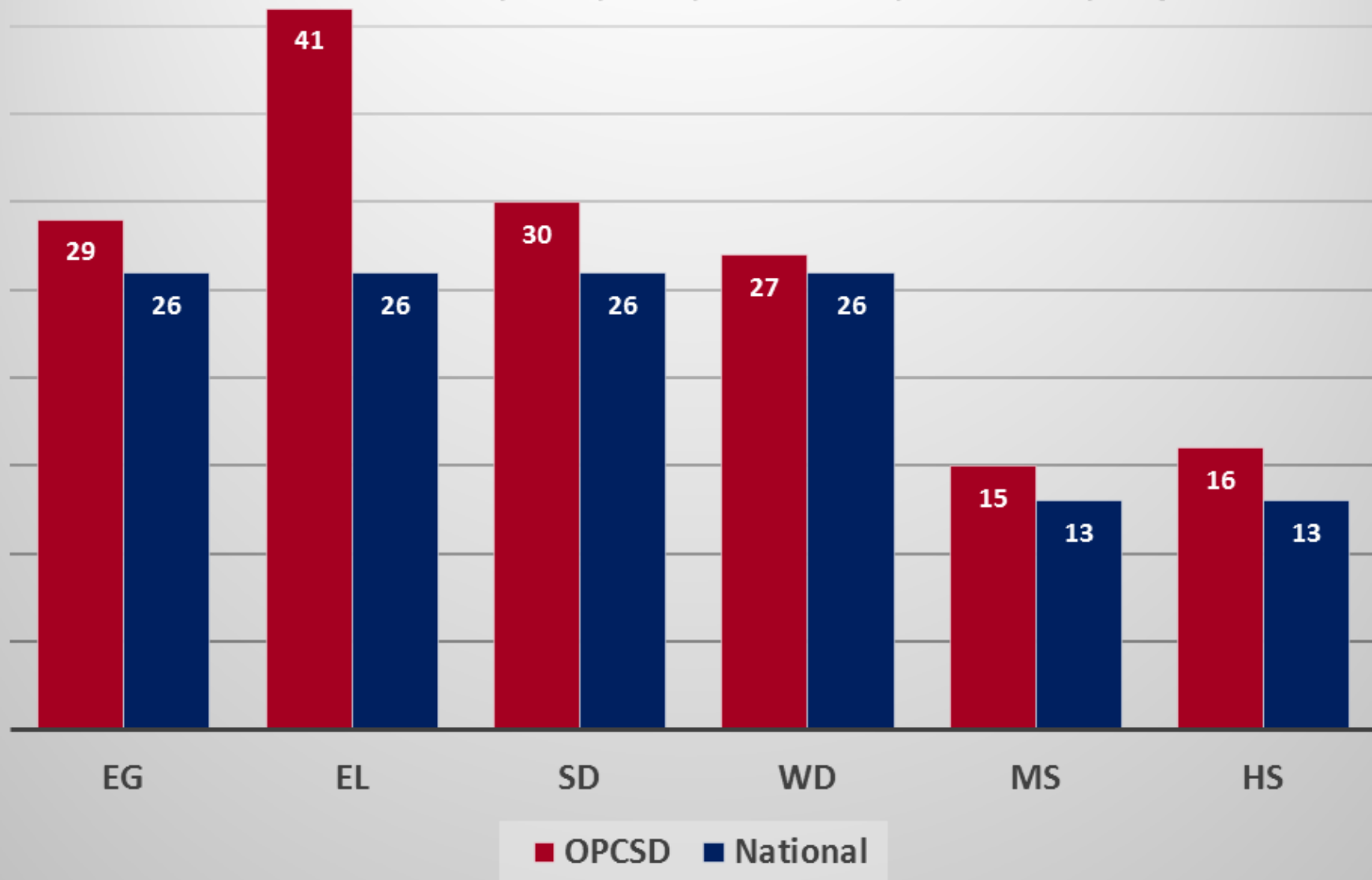
ALL Schools Trend - How often has a teacher spoken to you about bullying other students?

- BPCCs will analyze the 2016 questionnaire results
- Schools can focus efforts on new (or remaining) “hot spots”
- Continue classroom meetings to focus on areas of concern
 - **OPHS Classroom meetings special project, summer 2016**
- Continue the Peaceful School Bus Program



Orchard Park CSD as a model in Western New York

- Olweus implemented district-wide in Sept. 2010
 - Since then, our trainers:
 - Have trained 400+ educators at the WNY Character Council 2011-12 spring and fall conferences
 - Trained two other schools in the Olweus Bullying Prevention Program (Tonawanda City, Nativity, and Cassadaga Valley)
 - Consulted with 6 other public schools, 1 charter school, and 2 private schools considering this program
 - Continue to train community members: OPPD, YMCA, OP Town Rec, WNY Recreation Department Directors' Association
