CHANGES for 2021 – 2022

Our opportunities to fundraise continue to evolve as we monitor safety protocols, but there are still so many ways we can continue to support our Windom teachers and students. This year the money raised will be providing classroom and educational resources to the students of Windom Elementary School.

Here are just a few fundraising opportunities for our Windom Students.

PTO MEMBERSHIP DRIVE (runs through September 30th)

Our PTO Membership Drive is a way the PTO raises critical funds for our operating budget. The PTO is a collaboration of parents, teachers, and staff who support the learning of our students. Windom has 100% faculty and staff support and we

The minimum donation is \$5, but additional donation amounts are appreciated.

FALL & SPRING BOOK FAIRS

Working with a local vendor to supply a variety of books at great prices, the PTO tries to sponsor book fairs twice a year. Students can shop with their classroom during school hours. There is also an opportunity for students to shop with their families after school.

SQUARE 1 ART (EVERY 2 YEARS)

The Square 1 Art Fundraiser is a way for parents to preserve their child's art for years to come. Children create artwork in school based on a certain theme. Square 1 Art then transposes the art on various items offered through their catalog. These include mugs, canvas bags, magnets, and key chains to name a few. Parents, siblings, teachers, and staff are also encouraged to create art.

Before orders are placed, each child will go home with a sheet of stickers with their artwork on it and a detailed order form.



BOX TOPS

Collect box tops! **Clip or scan them,** even ask your friends & family to clip and save or scan their receipts to raise money for our Windom students. Box Tops are located on many grocery items such as cereal, snacks, popcorn, yogurt, and paper products such as Scott toilet paper, Ziploc bags, and Kleenex. Windom receives 10¢ for each one. In addition to the regular Box Tops, keep your eyes open for special bonus Box Tops on several products. You can even earn Box Top credit by downloading and using the free **Box Tops Bonus App**.

OLD BOX TOPS

You can still clip and send Box Tops into school with your child beginning today. Traditional Box Tops clips are being phased out of production but may continue to be found on many products throughout the store. Every valid Box Tops clip is worth 10¢ for your school. Make sure each one has a clearly visible product acronym and expiration date.

NEW BOX TOPS

You may have noticed some products you are purchasing no longer have the clip above box top on them. Now all you must do is scan your receipt, and our PTO gets money to spend on our Windom students. Use the new Box Tops app to scan your receipt. Box Tops are still worth 10¢ for our school. The app will find participating products purchased at any store and instantly add cash to your school's earnings online or download the app.

This is our largest fundraiser, which allows us to earn about \$15,000 based on pledges made from sponsors. Monies collected will generally go to bigger ticket items in need, such as new playground equipment, a new speaker system, etc. This character-building

event takes place over 2 weeks during the school day with daily fundraising challenges that allow the kids to earn individual and classroom prizes. It kicks off with a Pep-Rally and ends with a Fun Run. There is plenty of communication leading up to the event and during the event.
