

Emphasis is placed on active, hands-on group Competitions emphasizing hands-on, collaborative problem-solving, mirroring real-world scientific teamwork. Events like Elevated Bridge and Write It Do It require diverse skills, encouraging students to work together and utilize their strengths. Through the Science Olympiad, students develop skills in STEM, leadership and teamwork.

Students in 7th and 8th grade are welcome to join this competitive club. The club meets twice per week (Tuesdays and Thursdays) to prepare for invitational, regional and state-wide competitions. Teams are selected by the coaches based on student interest, club commitment and science/ technology preparation. In addition to the club meetings, students will need to continue their work and design at home to ensure that everyone is prepared for competition season in March and April.

The program culminates in regional and state tournaments, with top teams advancing to the National Tournament held at different universities each year. This experience offers students a chance to explore new places and potential colleges, creating lasting memories.

Science Olympiad promotes learning, teamwork, and community involvement bringing together students and teachers in a shared pursuit of excellence in science.
