

## Speech-Language Pathology Services

The Speech-Language Pathology Services Credential in Language, Speech and Hearing authorizes the holder to conduct applicable assessments as well as provide educational and other specific learning disability area services related to speech and language to qualifying students from birth through age 22.





Universities may vary on the exact requirements to enter their credential program. This credential also has a sequence of requirements to clear the credential which is different than typical CA educational credentials. See the university you are planning to attend, the <u>American</u> Speech-Language-Hearing Association, and the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC). for details.

If your degree is from outside the US, you must have your transcripts evaluated by an approved agency. <u>CTC - Foreign</u> <u>Transcript Evaluation</u>.

Certificate of Clearance (fingerprinting/background check) is required before you begin your practicum experience.
