Westerville City School District will be conducting initial radon testing during the week of winter break at Blendon MS, Minerva Park MS, Walnut Springs MS, Hawthorne ES, McVay ES and Pointview ES. This testing will be conducted per Ohio Department of Health regulations. Results of testing will be posted on the web site. In the event that elevated radon levels are detected, steps will be taken (per appropriate regulations) to correct any problems found. Note that Ohio Department of Health, U.S. EPA, and U.S. Surgeon General also recommend testing of all homes for radon since that is where families spend most of their time and, therefore, where a family can have its greatest exposure.
