- Participants commit to teaching in a high-needs area for LBUSD for each year the grant is received
- High needs areas include Special Education, Bilingual Authorization, Secondary Math and Science
- Credential and bachelor's degree options

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Classified employees
- Supervisor recommendation
- Meet university admissions requirements
- Grant contingent upon acceptance to the university and grant agreement
- Commitment to the inclusion of all members of a diverse workplace community
