## PEIMS: Under-reported Students

### Description

#### BRIEF INTRODUCTION:

Students will appear on the Presumed Underreported Students List in one of the following circumstances if they were NOT reported as Leavers by the district:

- Graduated high school or completed the General Educational Development (GED) program
- Moved to other educational setting (i.e. Private School, Home Schooling)
- Withdrawn by school district
- Repeating 7th graders
- Student was/is being reported with incorrect AS-OF-STATUS-CODE or no leaver record was created

The following circumstances will allow students to show on the Presumed Underreported Students List without a Leaver code

- Unique ID was retired
- GED was reported without an SSN

#### TASK / DESCRIPTION / DIAGNOSIS:

##### Unique ID Retired:

A retired Unique ID may appear on the FALL PEIMS Presumed Underreported Students List due to the Unique ID being reported in the previous school year submission for enrollment and attendance prior to being retired. Since this Unique ID is not being used in enrollment for the current school year, it will appear that the student is no longer being reported.

This retired Unique ID will remain as an Underreported, and there is nothing to be done to clear this record. For auditing, you can match the Unique ID that was retired to the current Unique ID by going into the TSDS Unique ID application and searching for the retired Unique ID.

**Completed high school or General Educational Development (GED) program (01,85,86,90)** - please see TWEDS PEIMS Leaver Data - Leaver Reason Codes and Documentation Requirements <https://tealprod.tea.state.tx.us/TWEDS/87/0/0/0/DataSubmission/TechnicalResources/1209> for further information

A student registered for the GED test must provide matching SSN that is in the Unique ID database during the testing. The testing agency does not require the student to provide SSN and therefore, if the student information doesn't match with Unique ID database, the student will remain on the Underreported list.

**Moved to other educational setting (24,60,66,81,82,87)** - please see TWEDS PEIMS Leaver Data - Leaver Reason Codes and Documentation Requirements <https://tealprod.tea.state.tx.us/TWEDS/87/0/0/0/DataSubmission/TechnicalResources/1209> for further information

If the student was enrolled with the district last year and moved to another district this year, the proper LEAVER-REASON-CODE (E1001) must be submitted during the current school year to reflect the change.

Note: LEAVER-REASON-CODE indicates the reason a prior year student in grade 7-12 student has not enrolled in the district during the current school year

Question: If a student moves from District A to District B, but District B does not report them in the PEIMS collection, how does District A clear the student from the Presumed Underreported report?

Answer: The LEA has the following three options:

1. Leave the student as underreported- this will affect the underreported count.
2. Enter a Leaver Code.
3. Contact district B to determine whether the student attended and if so, they should report a leaver record for the current school year. This will clear the underreported student.

**78** - Student was expelled under the provisions of TEC §37.007 and cannot return to school

**83** - Student was attending and was withdrawn from school by the district when the district discovered that the student was not entitled to enrollment in the district because a) the student was not a resident of the district, b) was not entitled under other provisions of TEC §25.001 or as a transfer student, or c) was not entitled to public school enrollment under TEC §38.001 or a corresponding rule of the Texas Department of State Health Services because the student was not immunized.

**Repeating 7th graders**

If the students repeat grade 7, they should not be coded as As-of code of X. Only EE-06 and first-time 7th graders can have an As-of code X. As per TEDS Section 2.4, repeating 7th grader should have a code of A-G. Otherwise, these students will remain on the Underreported report.

**Student was/is being reported with incorrect AS-OF-STATUS-CODE or no leaver record was created**

A student with an incorrect AS-OF-STATUS-CODE in a previous or current collection or no leaver record will not be reflected correctly during the current school year. The LEA will need to verify that their data is correct and, in some cases, may need to contact the prior district to verify information.

Please refer to the chart below on what coding should be used for the student.
