

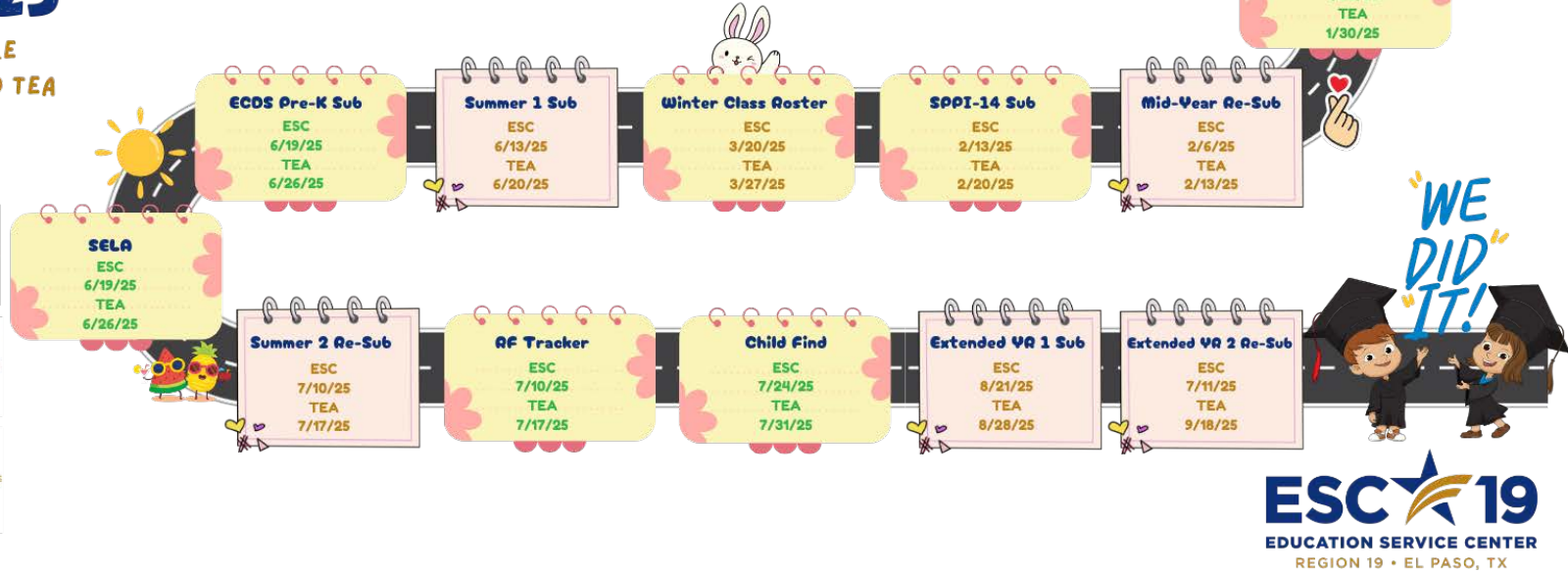

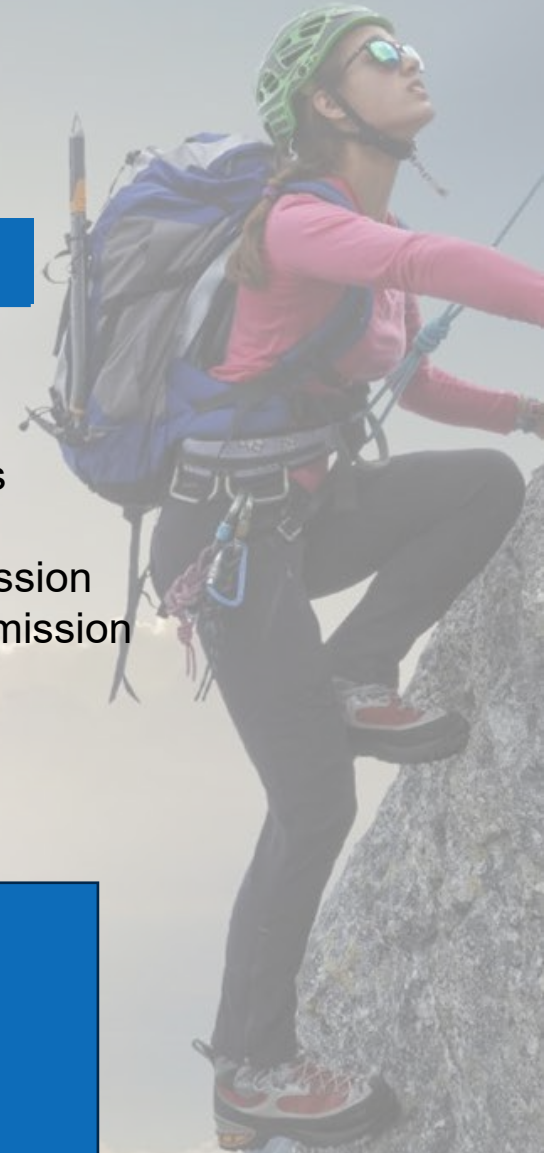

The 2024-2025 Texas Student Data System (TSDS) Texas Education Data Standards (TEDS) **Post-Addendum version 2025.2.1** is now available.

- TEDS is accessed via the [TSDS Web-Enabled Data Standards \(TWEDS\)](#).

## Some changes to note:

- Sunset of Remote Synchronous (RS) and Remote Asynchronous (RA) data elements and descriptors.
- Sunset of the MilitaryEnlistmentIndicator (E1589)
- Sunset of the StudentCharacteristic descriptor 05 (C344) for Texas Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (T-STEM)
- Early Notice for Leavers and Graduates Changes

### DR1

#### School Reference

The School Reference represents the identifier assigned to a school.

#### Student Reference

The Student Reference represents the identifier assigned to a student.

**SchoolYear (E1093)** is the identifier for the school year associated with the Calendar.

**Term** is required in the Ed-Fi model and is mandatory for the entity to be loaded into the individual operational data store (IODS). Term will not be promoted to TSDS.

- If a student is assigned 60 hours of accelerated instruction, the LEA would need to report that the student completed the total number of hours. The domain of values for **Completed Hours Accelerated Instruction (E3087)** was 00.00-30.00. If a student completes 60 hours, the LEA will need to report the total. This was updated in the 2025.2.1 version.
