WELCOME

STEVEN SHIELS, DIRECTOR OF GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING

- Quaver Ready lessons for grades 1 and 4 would need to be SHAC approved.
 Lessons are for group guidance; parents must opt-in. These are specific lessons that address child abuse/victimization. Provides a consistent resource for counselors to use (currently have Great Expectations but no curriculum to teach; saves them preparation time)
- Review questions and feedback time: boys/girls separate? How many is too many when dealing with sensitive material? Is 1st grade too young for material?

Journaling activity- who keeps those papers the students or counselors, and how do we safeguard and handle those student resources? Has there been feedback from other districts using it? Is it possible to have a pilot campus in Tomball?

- Overall liked by members and said it was age appropriate, had good topics/advice overall but had a few concerns that parents may object to or want addressed before complete approval.
- Next step- approval? Vote taken approving use of lessons pending pilot campus feedback at next meeting; Motion approved by committee.
