

## Los Alamitos Unified School District HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT ENROLLMENT

We welcome your student to the Los Alamitos Unified School District and hope he/she will have a very healthy and happy year! To ensure the optimum health of students and to comply with district, county, and state requirements, please note the following health requirements that must be met for enrollment:

### 1. IMMUNIZATIONS FOR SCHOOL

- Submit all shot records to enroll your child for school
- If your child's immunization record is not complete: *Call your medical provider now and make an appointment to receive missing required missing vaccines prior to enrollment.*
- All required vaccinations must be submitted to complete the enrollment process.

Required Vaccine	TK/K-12 <sup>th</sup> grade Admission	Notes for School Requirements	7 <sup>th</sup> grade Advancement
IPV/OPV (Polio)	<b>4 Polio</b>	<b>4 doses meet TK/K-12 requirement, as do: 3 doses, if &gt;1 dose given at age &gt;4 years.</b>	Must meet all K-12 grade requirements and will also need proof of Tdap given on or after 7th birthday.
<b>DTaP / DTP</b> – Age 0-6 yrs <b>Tdap / Td</b> – Age 7+ yrs (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis)	<b>5 DTaP</b>	<b>5 doses meet TK/K-12 requirement, as do: 4 doses, if &gt;1 dose given at age &gt;4 years; 3 doses, if &gt;1 Tdap dose at age &gt;7 years; Tdap dose may meet 7th Grade requirement.</b>	
<b>MMR</b> (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)	<b>2 MMR</b>	<b>2 doses meet TK/K-12 requirement. Doses must be given at age &gt;1 year.</b>	
Hep B (Hepatitis B)	<b>3 Hep B</b>	<b>3 doses meet TK/K-12 requirement</b>	
<b>VAR/VZV</b> (Varicella or Chicken pox)	<b>2 Varicella</b>	<b>2 doses meet TK/K-12 requirement.</b>	
<b>1 Tdap</b> –for 7-12 gr. (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)	<b>1 Tdap</b>	1 dose Tdap given after 7 years of age meets requirement for 7th grade advancement and 7th-12th grade admission.	

For students who are **3 years old at the time of admission** to TK ([Education Code section 48000\[c\]](#)), schools are recommended to initially apply the [pre-kindergarten immunization requirements](#) (PDF) and to follow up with these students once they turn 4 years old to apply the TK/K immunization requirements.

### 2. ORAL HEALTH ASSESSMENT FOR TK/KINDERGARTEN

California law (Education Code Section 49452.8) states your child must have a dental check-up in kindergarten or first grade, whichever is his/her first year of public school. A California licensed dental professional operating within his scope of practice must perform the check-up and complete Section 2 of the Oral Health Assessment Form. Dental check-ups performed within the 12 months before your child enters school also meet this requirement.

**Please note:** *Students will not be enrolled or admitted to class until the required immunization records are submitted.*
