

CCMS LADY CAV WINNING STREAK HITS 10; BOYS EDGED OUT BY UNION CITY

An eight-point third quarter by Khylie Cobb and perfection from the free throw line by Jentry Maddox in the final period sparked Crockett County Middle School's Lady Cavaliers to their tenth consecutive victory Monday night, defeating host Union City 38-27.

Coach Jamar Turner's Lady Cavs used a 14-2 advantage in the third frame to blow open what was a close game at halftime (16-14), and then withstood a fourth-stanza rally by the Lady Tornados as Maddox knocked in four straight free throws.

For the game, Crockett was 7-for-7 from the foul line as a team. Maddox and Cobb paced the Lady Cav offense with 15 and 12 points, respectively. Lola Bailey added five, including Crockett's only three-pointer, as the visitors improved their season record to 12-3.

In the boys game, after falling behind 29-17 in the first half, Coach Tyler Gadlen's club made things interesting by winning the third quarter 15-9. But Union City held on for a 55-47 triumph, dropping the Cavs to 8-7 on the season despite a 19-point performance from Brody Haley, who netted four threes.

Will Dodds added 13 for the Cavs and Jeremiah Young scored seven. Crockett shot just five throws, while the host Tornados were awarded 17.

Both CCMS teams are next in action on Thursday night in a twin bill at Martin.
