

Facilities & Grounds Liaison Report

December 12, 2024

- Rt. 772 flashing school signs installation is being held up due to an easement that still needs to be signed by a neighbor. A contractor has been named and is ready to move forward as soon as the easement is signed.
- On 11/26 we met with DEP for a scheduled inspection of the domestic water system at Paradise Elementary. We had our first completely clean inspection for the first time since Paradise was constructed.
- We are still waiting on final estimates from H&H Mechanical for the repair or replacement of the heat pump at Paradise Elementary.
- We are looking at incorporating the larger heat pump replacement project at Paradise Elementary into an energy efficiency study. Grants have become available for improving applied systems. Grant funds may apply if we view the heat pumps as part of the geothermal system. Ephrata and Central Dauphin School Districts have recently done similar studies in conjunction with Trane's Complex Energy Solutions division.
- I ordered a new slide for the playground at Salisbury due to a crack in the current slide.
- My staff and I have started to have trainings on multiple systems at the new 7-12 building.
