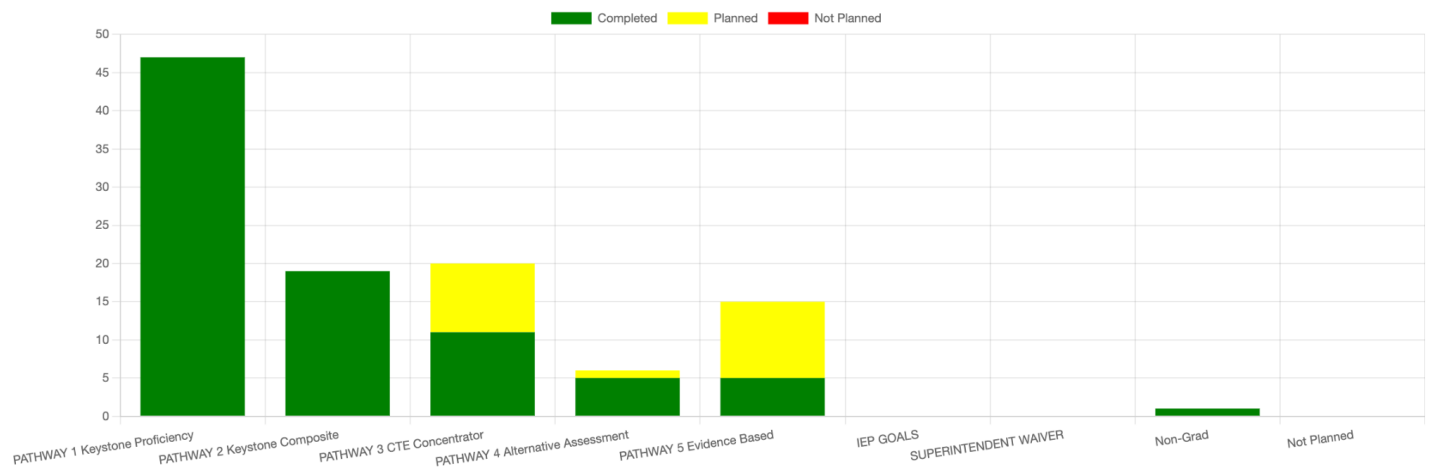

- 2 Learners in CTC will earn credentials

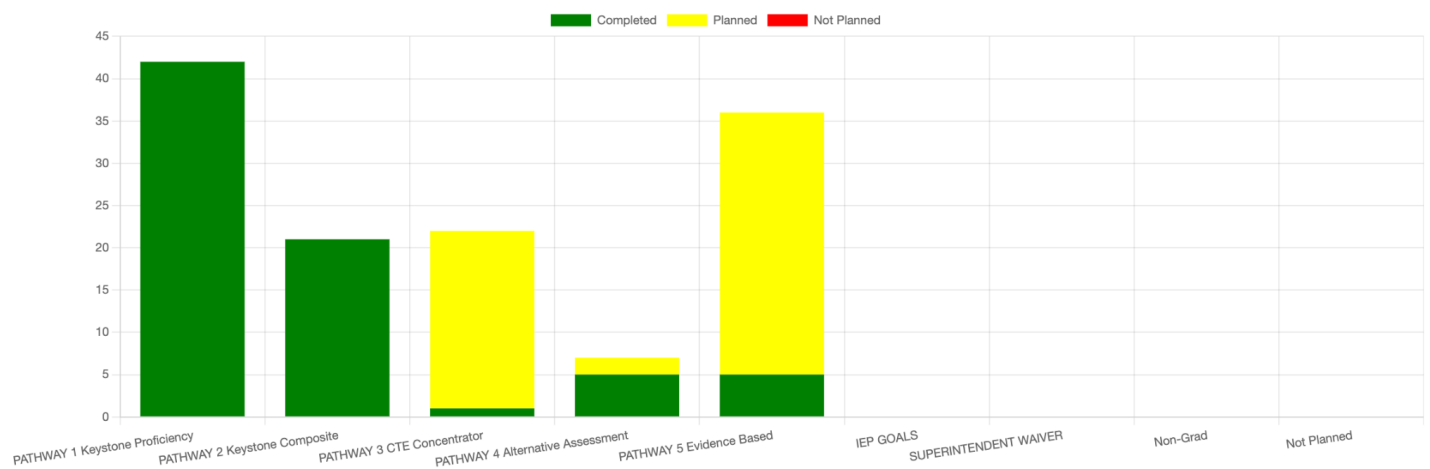
