



# Foundation 649 Scholarship

This scholarship is offered by **Foundation 649**, the application is due **03/01/2025**. The application process started on 10/01/2024.

## Scholarship Details

**Description** The Foundation 649 Scholarship is a grant of \$4,000 over the course of 4 years that can be applied to college tuition and expenses. To maintain eligibility each year, there will be a brief check-in and renewal process at the end of each school year.

### Details

Five recipients will be selected  
Each recipient will receive an award of \$4,000 USD spread over 4 years  
The award must be renewed each year to receive successive funds (details to come)  
Application deadline is March 1, 2025  
10 entrants will be selected as finalists for video call interviews by March 31, 2025  
Recipients are announced by April 15, 2025

### Requirements

Be a degree-seeking, full-time student enrolling in a U.S. accredited university in Fall 2025 as a Freshman or transferring from a community college  
Identify as Asian American / Pacific Islander  
Have a track record of involvement and interest in AAPI communities, issues, or causes  
Have demonstrated financial need for the scholarship  
Be a US citizen, resident, or foreign national. Undocumented students are also welcome to apply.

### Application

2025 Prompt: Describe how your community uniquely contributes to the broader AAPI experience. The application consists of a questionnaire and a short essay (1000 word maximum). We want to hear your stories - we encourage creativity and originality (this should not be a rehash of your resume)! Alternate media will also be accepted in place of the essay if you choose (e.g. film, photography, etc.). If you are selected as a recipient, with your permission, we plan to share your submission with our audiences.

In addition, applicants should provide the FAFSA SAR (student aid report) that show their EFC (expected family contribution). If you are unable to provide this document, please provide substitute documentation (tax documents, W2, etc.) and elaborate in the financial aid section.
