### Boys Basketball (7th & 8th Grade)

Boys Basketball is a **tryout** sport, available to all boys in 7th and 8th grade. Due to limited spots on the team, tryouts will be held. If the number of players that tryout exceeds the number of spots available, cuts will be made. Registration and fee are due **after the tryout** once teams have been announced. All athletes must be registered and all forms must be submitted via CampDoc in order to participate in any sport.

Both schools compete in the Jr. Parkland Conference. Teams will practice or play a game everyday during the week, Monday-Thursday. Game times are 3:30pm or 4:30pm. Bussing is provided to all away games. Practices are 3:15-5:00pm. The season concludes mid January.

### Wrestling (6th, 7th, 8th Grade)

Wrestling is available to all students in 6th, 7th and 8th grade. Anyone who registers is allowed to participate. Registration, payment and required forms are due **before** the start date. All athletes must be registered and all forms must be submitted in order to participate in any sport.

**Start Date: Thursday, January 2, 3:15-5:00pm**

Both schools compete in the Milwaukee Area Conference. Teams will practice or have a match everyday during the week, Monday-Thursday. Matches start at 4:00pm. Bussing is provided to all away matches. Practices are 3:15-5:00pm. The season concludes the first week of March with a conference tournament.

## Girls Volleyball (7th & 8th Grade)

Girls Volleyball is a **tryout** sport, available to all girls in 7th and 8th grade. Due to limited spots on the team, tryouts will be held.. If the number of players that tryout exceeds the number of spots available, cuts will be made. Registration and fee are due **after the tryout** once teams have been announced.. All athletes must be registered and all forms must be submitted in order to participate in any sport.

## REQUIRED FORMS

All students who participate in an athletic program at your school must have the following forms completed on CampDoc and must have a profile completion percentage of 100% in order to participate in practice or competition. Any athlete that does not have all the necessary information submitted to their profile will not be allowed to participate until that has been done.

- **Physical Exam Form** (good for 2 years, see physical exam form for specific date clarifications)
- **Physical Exam Alternate Year Card** (must be filled out the following year after physical exam is completed)
- **Student Athlete Emergency Information, Consent to Treat and Authorization to Disclose Medical Information Form** (only needs to be done once per school year)
- **Concussion & Sudden Cardiac Arrest Form** (only needs to be completed once per school year)
- **Intermediate School Athletic Code of Conduct Form** (only needs to be completed once per school year)

## REGISTRATION PROCESS/FEES

Registration must be completed directly through the West Allis-West Milwaukee Recreation and Community Services Department. **\$45 per sport (Except 6th grade track, which is \$20).** If the sport has a tryout, payment is due after final rosters have been made and sent to the WAWM RCS Department. Players can not participate in practices or games until the payment is made.

Note\* No money will be accepted at your school. All money is collected and handled at the WAWM RCS Department.
