Dear Parent/Guardian of a Hockinson School District Student:

DO NOT PROVIDE INFORMATION TO THE MILITARY

With the passage of the No Child Left Behind Act, principals and other educators are required to comply with new federal mandates to release Junior (11th Grade) and Senior (12th Grade) student information to the military recruiter system. This information will include your student's name, address, and phone number. The "No Child Left Behind Act" states that high schools must provide student information to the Defense Department upon request unless parent/guardians object in writing. This requirement applies to all public and private schools that receive federal funding. Schools that fail to comply risk losing their funding.

If you object to your child's information being provided to the Defense Department for recruitment purposes, please fill out the form below and return it to your student's school office before **September 30th of their Junior year** to ensure their information is not released.

This form can be returned after that time but does **not** remove their information from any lists released prior.
