ABOUT THE PROGRAM

This is a complete, professionally taught Driver Education Program that will provide students with a comprehensive introduction to the driving experience. Students must complete 16 sessions of in-car and 16 sessions of classroom instruction with a passing grade of 65 in each category. At the end of all 32 sessions (16 car and 16 lectures) students will have received 24 hours of classroom instruction and 24 hours of in-car driving related to "Rules of the Road," traffic safety concerns, defensive driving, proper handling of a vehicle, parking, driving in traffic and problems of substance abuse as related to driving.

WHAT THE PROGRAM OFFERS

It includes the MV285 Completion Certificate, an insurance reduction to students who qualify and a senior driver license Class D at age 17 upon passing the DMV Road Test.

ELIGIBILITY

Students must be 16 years old, **must have a Learner Permit before the first class**, and must be a student in good standing as per the High School Eligibility Procedure and Student Code of Conduct. Students must reside within the Baldwin Union Free School District. All applications will be handled on a first come, first served basis. Payment alone does not constitute registration. Please see below.

REGISTRATION

Fill out this application and return it with a **photocopy** of your permit or junior license, a copy of your **receipt** for payment to Patti Sisco in the HS Main Office and a copy of the family car insurance card.

REFUND POLICY

If a student cannot be accommodated because classes are filled, all monies will be refunded. If a student cancels one week prior to the first class, a \$30 administrative charge will be deducted from the refund. If a student withdraws the day before the first class, only a 50% refund will be granted. Thereafter, no tuition refund will be authorized.

ABSENCES/MAKE-UPS

By New York State Education regulations, a student is allowed to make up no more than 3 absences. It is the student's responsibility to make arrangements with, and obtain prior approval from, the regular driving and/or lecture instructor to proceed with any make-up assignments. More than 3 absences will result in the student being dropped from the program and no refund will be issued.

STUDENT OBLIGATION FORM

1. I will always obey all New York State Vehicle and Traffic Laws.
2. I will obtain a New York State Learner Permit.
3. I understand that I must successfully complete the theory and road portions of the program in order to receive a Completion Certificate.
4. I understand that to successfully complete the theory and road test portions of the program, my attendance is essential to fulfilling minimum State Education requirements.
