### Agenda

- From last meeting
  - Add new courses to crosswalk (12/10/14-Asbury- KINE 2356, CHEM 1406, HECO 1322, BIOL 2420)
    - -HECO 1322 [Nutrition and Diet Therapy] might be nutrition? Or bio, nutrition for nursing
    - -KINE 2356? Unsure of what that is. -Send an email to add these; the courses need to fit into one of these programs; add where you want the classes, which degree plan they fit into, and PEIMS Number
  - Finish planning chili cook-off (12/10/24 Asbury- this is done. Fabian confirmed the table reservation and Carlie confirmed the room reservation. Flyer was sent out to Dept chairs and others. TABS staff is working on getting the meal and door prizes together.
  - Look into allegations of disrespectful behavior by TCC speech instructor ( 12/10/24- Asbury and Dept Chair left messages but as stated in our meeting previously, it's just "a heads up" right now because I don't have concrete information to give him on the exact things that were said/done).
- New
  - Asbury- (12/10/24)Notification was sent to Dr. Smart and Dr. Schrantz to not cancel SPAN 1412 and ARTS 1301 TABS only sections since they will have enrollments put in until Jan. 15<sup>th</sup> due to TSI testing
    - TSI testing for around 20 9<sup>th</sup> graders. ELAR MC
    - Testing will be notified about these students being tested; courses of concern are embedded
    - Dr. McGowan will talk to Dr. Smart about these classes not being cancelled.
  - 9<sup>th</sup> grade TSI English testing: Jan. 7-10<sup>th</sup> ideally, maybe use Jan. 13<sup>th</sup>, if needed. Wooddell to verify tests were sent to TCC Jan. 13-14<sup>th</sup>. Munoz sends Enrollment rosters to registrar for eligible students to enter Jan. 15<sup>th</sup>. Registrar enrolls students by Jan. 17<sup>th</sup>. Classes begin Jan. 21.
  - Asbury- Has there been an update on summer registration restrictions or changes? If so, what are they? If not, do you know when we will get them?
    - Restrictions remain the same; send overloads to Dr. McGowan.
    - Need to know which students are planning to take summer courses that FWISD is willing to pay the books for.. B/c rest will need to use concurrent enrollment.. Little control of which courses/books; if TABS wants to have exclusive sections , such as embedded.. (embedded doesn't have

- Asbury- Have there been any changes made or restrictions/requirements for the registration process for spring for ECHS?
  - Students typically do well in restricted courses on a waiver...
- Asbury- Is there a TCC rule/policy in place for students in regards to using Ai tools (ChatGPT, etc.) on assignments/papers, if any? If there is one, please send a link so it can be distributed to students.
  - Some instructors will place it into syllabus, up to discretion of professor. Will investigate if there are blanket policies – have not heard that TCC has any.
- Dr. Davis asked for summer courses.
- In midst of recruiting season for next school year at TABS
  - If FWISD/TABS guarantees residency, can TCC do so as well? Has been an issue recently – students having to fill out all the residency paperwork
  - Will have list at end of January of students for next year
- TABS expanding partnership with UNT HSC.
- TABS has students in Central Sterile Processing right now
  - TABS will investigate if its a viable path for the students/what outcomes are for past students; it is currently a low enrollment program for TCC; most places that have sterile processing have a small room, difficult to get students in; have already recruited a new group for year (13-15) , but also have spots in other programs for those students – Biomedical Lab Tech Is having success (5 students have gotten certified) ; TCC might need help them getting into rotations..
  - Surgical Technician sounds interesting, Central Sterile Processing can lead up to? -- this can be a way to sell it. Get CSP and Surgical Technician could be a next step.
  - What programs in Health Sciences can High School students participate in? LVN – 12 months; ADN – a little longer than 2 years b/c they need prerequisites; Ed Partnerships can revisit LVN w/ nursing department, board of nursing has become more open to it; TCC for CNA currently requires 12 hours clinical (continuous)
  - RN to BSN fast track , more seamless possibility w/ UNTHSC..
- Can TABS be notified when Café is filled, so TABS students can have a place to eat. 250 kids will able to eat there .. and then the students will then go all over campus/stairwells , etc.
  - Isaac, get calendar to notify TABS when the Café is closed. When seating area is closed during lunch/not set up for lunch
