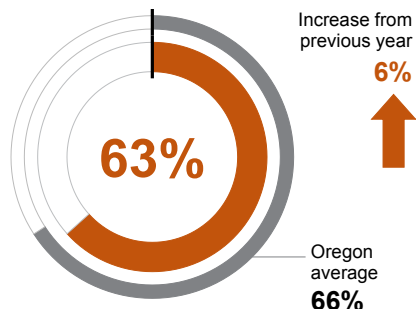

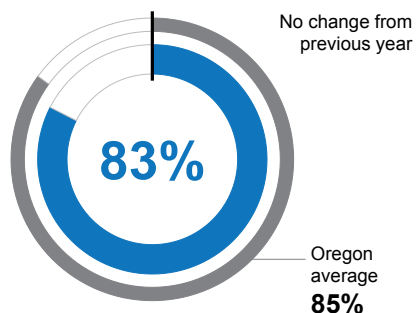

District Goals

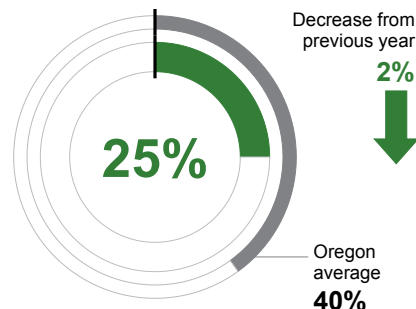

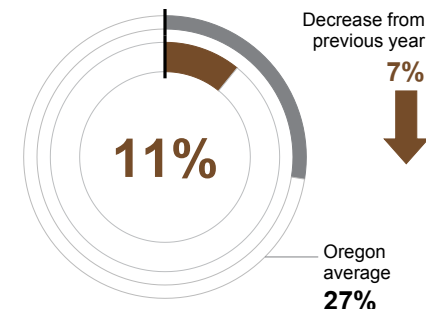
Students meeting state grade-level expectations.

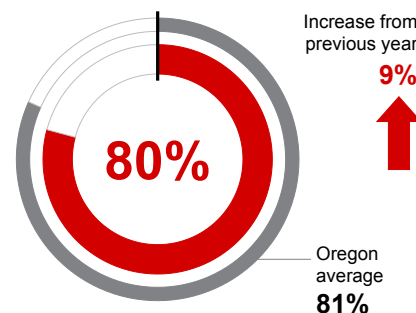
MATHEMATICS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



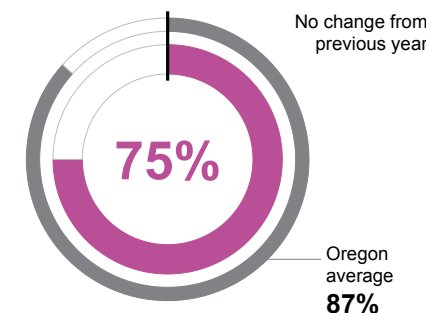
ON-TIME GRADUATION
