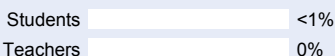

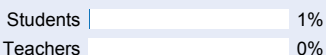

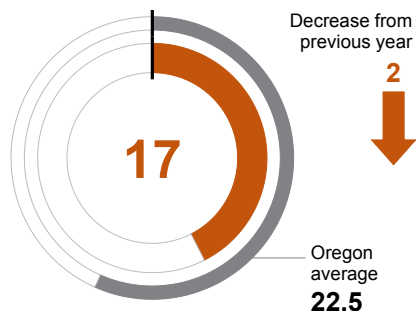

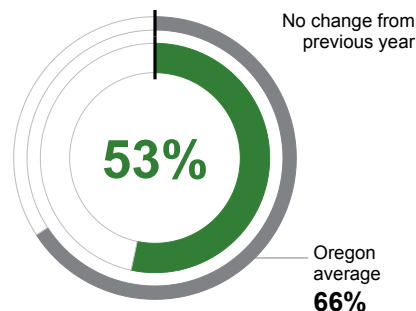
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

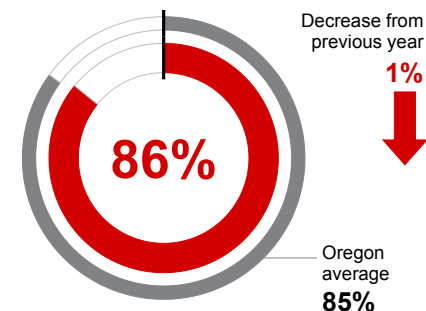
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

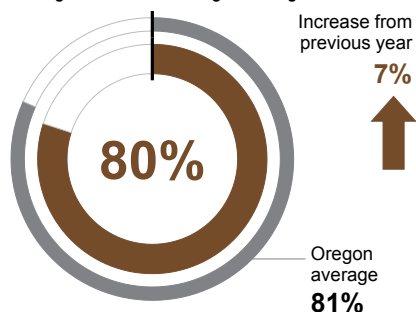
Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.

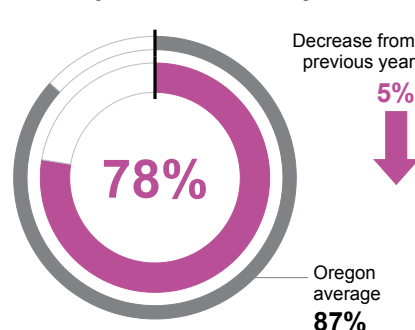
ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2019-20 graduating in 2022-23.



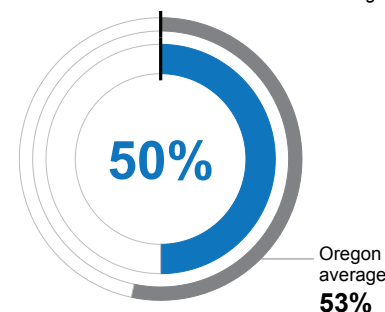
FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

About Our School

ADVANCED COURSEWORK

Our advanced courses include Honors US History, Honors English (10-12th), Pre-Calculus, Calculus, Ag Leadership, and Spanish. We also offer dual credit courses through Southern Oregon University and Rogue Community College which allow students to get college credit at no cost to the students or families. In addition, we allow students who are ahead of track for graduation to dual enroll at Rogue Community College and take courses at one of the Rogue Community College campuses free of cost to the students and their families while earning both high school and college credit.

CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

We are proud of the CTE offerings at RRJSHS. We have an exceptional Agriculture CTE program of study which allows students to gain career readiness skills. Nearly 50% of our students are engaged in an FFA program. In addition, our students take 7th and 8th grade Success, Freshman Success and Junior Life Beyond Rogue River courses which combine attributes of AVID with college and career readiness skills. Taking both required courses provides students with multiple opportunities to explore real world challenges and build a solid foundation to grow upon while meeting personal goals and plan for post high school opportunities.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

We have a range of OSAA Division III teams as well as Jr. High sports programs. Our FFA chapter is currently one of the most competitive in Oregon and continues to excel in state and national level competitions. Our Arden Ensemble puts on three performances annually with a student cast from grades 7-12 taking on both acting and back-stage responsibilities. After school opportunities for all students also include an Art Club, GSA club, and tutoring.

PARENT & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

RRJSHS is a tight-knit community where students are able to get involved in fun and relevant activities throughout the school year. We start our school year with a Back to School Bash, inviting families into the building before school starts to learn about opportunities for students to be involved as well as for opportunities for parents to be a part of the school community. Conference days allow us the opportunity to offer mini-sessions that are relevant to families as well as provide space for showcasing student work. In the spring we have an Art Show for grades 7-12, as well as offer multiple drama performances. Our FFA chapter hosts an annual Beef Feed and Auction in February that is a consistent crowd pleaser and is highly attended by the community.
