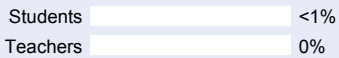

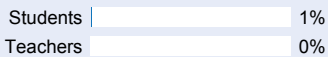

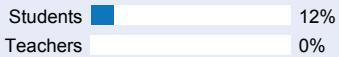

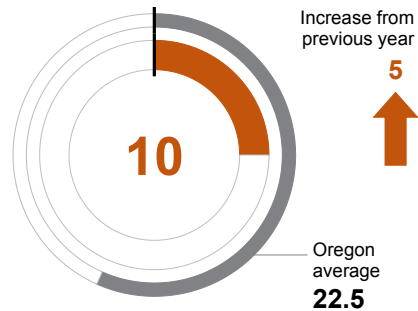

School Environment

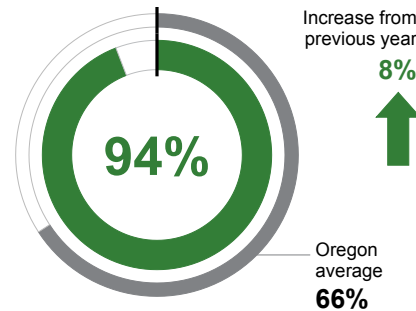
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

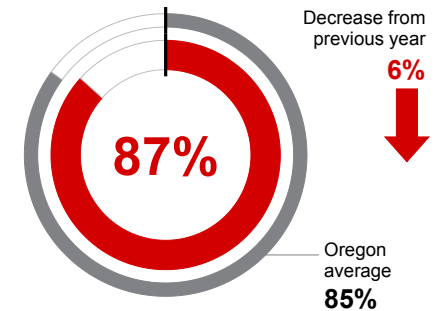
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

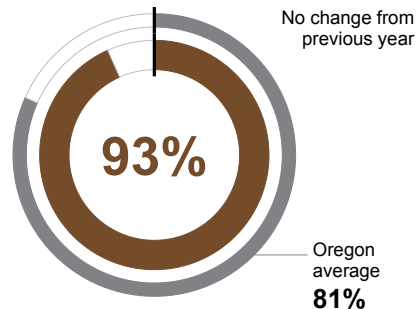
Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.



Academic Success

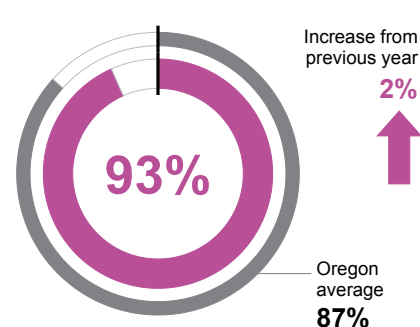
ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2019-20 graduating in 2022-23.



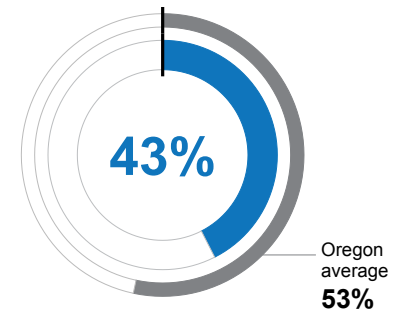
FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

School Goals

We believe that every student is unique with their own approach towards learning and that an effective school must provide a variety of quality educational choices and options to meet the varying needs and goals of individual students. All students have a personalized learning plan. Even with the challenges of the past few years, our staff has rallied around our students to support their success. We are at or above state averages for On-Track to graduate, On-time Graduation, & Five-Year Completion. We continue to maintain small class sizes for our hybrid learning mode and offer project-based learning opportunities.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is collaborating with school districts and communities across the state to achieve a 90% on-time graduation rate by 2027. Grounded in the pillars of Academic Excellence, Belonging and Wellness, and Reimagined Accountability, ODE prioritizes evidence-based practices to boost early literacy, attendance, and student engagement. We are committed to closing opportunity and achievement gaps for marginalized students and securing long-term success for all of Oregon's learners by investing in culturally responsive practices, fostering inclusive environments and always driving for continuous improvement.

Safe & Welcoming Environment

As a small school, we have worked to make sure all students feel safe while on campus, by implementing protocols for entry into our buildings along cleaning and sanitizing procedures. Every student is ensured to have a competent and caring adult they are contacting daily. Our Student Intervention Team encourages all of our students to speak up when they see bullying. All students, activities, and coursework are viewed with an equity lens.

ADVANCED COURSEWORK
