C. Approved Spotts, Stevens and McCoy (SSM) authorization for services at the High School as part of the renovations and additions project, at a cost of \$13,600. (Board Attachment).

Background: This service is to provide lead abatement oversight and air monitoring for the removal of the lead paint flooring in the shop areas.

- D. Approved adding one electrical account to the recommended Utility Rates Analysts (URA) supply rate for a 15-month period. (Board Attachment).

 Background: URA identified an electrical account on the Met-Ed default rate and the recommended supplier, AEP, which is projected to save the District \$9,500.00 over 15-month period.
- E. Approved an agreement with Learning Opportunity Group through IU13, to provide professional services effective and retroactive from March 25, 2024, through June 30, 2024 for the Interim Middle School Assistant Principal position at a daily rate of \$365.00. (Board Attachment).

Background: The Interim Middle School Assistant Principal will be on site for up to four days per week until on or before June 5, 2024. This interim Assistant Principal position is in effect for the end of the 2023-2024 school year due to a resignation.
