Welcome to the ELCO School District and it is important to complete the information below which will allow the incoming and outgoing school to adhere to the integrity of the PIAA transfer policies.

If you participated in athletics at your previous school it is required to complete the PIAA transfer form and meet with the high school principal and then meet with the out-going principal of the transferring school.

Checklist to follow:

- Complete information above
- If sports were played, the student and parent must complete the transfer form.
- After completing the form, the parents and student must meet with HS principal to review the form and questions and principal must sign form.
- The form will be sent to the outgoing school and the HS principal informs the parents and students that the other school must sign in order for them to participate at the new school.
- The outgoing school must complete the form and send it back to the ingoing school and if they refuse to sign it they must meet with the parents and student.



TRANSFERS

- A transfer occurs when a student is enrolled at one school and wants to enroll at another school and play a sport at that school.
- If a student didn't play a sport at his/her previous school, that student is eligible to play that sport at the new school.
- If a student makes a transfer and played a sport at the previous school and wants to play the same sport at the new school, the new school must complete the Athletic Transfer Waiver Request form which is located on the PIAA website under the Forms section. This document should be filled out by the new school when the student enrolls. The new school's principal should interview the student and determine whether the transfer to new the school was motivated in a material way by athletics. Upon making that determination, the new school should send the form to the school the student previously attended. The principal at the former school needs to make the same determination. Typically, the principal of the school the student left should interview the student and his/her parents to make a determination about whether that principal believes the transfer was materially motivated by athletic reasons. Once the form is completed by both principals, it must be submitted to the District III Executive Director for approval by the District III Committee.
- There are certain situations where students are automatically eligible for interscholastic athletics without schools having to submit the Athletic Transfer Waiver Request form and gain district approval. The following situations grant student automatic athletic eligibility:
- 1. **Natural Break** The break between elementary school and junior high would provide automatic eligibility (6th grade to 7th grade). Another natural break would occur between junior high/middle school and high school (many times 8th grade to 9th grade).
- 2. **Administrative Transfer** There is an administrative decision to move a student between two schools within the same public school district or, if previously enrolled at a Catholic school, within the same Archdiocese.
- 3. Change of Residence of Parents The student and his entire family (natural parents and/or adopted parents) have moved into the new school district and purchased a home. This would also be the case for a family that rents a home. However, in the case of rentals, if there is anything unusual about the rental, it is always best in that situation to fill out the Athletic Transfer Waiver form.

If parents have a legal separation or divorce and a student moves into a new school district with one of the parents, that student is granted automatic eligibility. However, if the separation is not recognized by the courts, an Athletic Transfer Waiver form should be filled out.

If a student whose parents are separated transfers from the school district where one parent lives to the school district where the other parent lives more than one time, the second transfer must be approved using the Athletic transfer Waiver form.

- 4. Change of Residence of Legal Guardians In this situation, the courts would have to appoint a legal guardian for the student. The legal guardian would live in a geographic area which requires the student to transfer to a new school.
- 5. Change of Residence of Foster Parents In this situation, a local child welfare organization would have to place the student in a new foster care situation. The foster care family would live in a geographic area which requires the student to transfer to a new school.

- 6. School Closing The school the student previously attended has closed.
- 7. **Boarding School Student** The student has previously been enrolled at a boarding school where he/she lived on the school's campus. The transfer must have been made to the local school where the student would attend by virtue of his/her residence.

If the principal of the previous school signs the Athletic Transfer Waiver form on section B indicating that he/she believes that transfers of athletically motivated, both schools will be involved in a hearing with the District III Committee. This is an informal hearing before members of the Committee where both schools and/or the student and parents have an opportunity to explain why they believe or don't believe the transfer was athletically motivated. Following the hearing, the District III Committee will vote in an open session to make an eligibility determination. The District III Committee could grant the student athletic eligibility at the new school, the Committee could request more information before rendering a decision, or the Committee could deny eligibility for a person of 1 year. If eligibility is denied, the student may not participate in the sport he/she played in the previous school for a period of 1 year. The student is still able to practice with the team at the new school, but the student cannot participate in any PIAA scrimmages or games. However, the student may participate in any sports that he/she didn't play at the previous school.

If a student's is denied eligibility by the District III Committee, the new school (not the student or the parent/s – it must be done by the school) may request an appeal with the PIAA Board of Directors. In this situation, the hearing is presented to members of the PIAA Board, although no new information may be presented. The PIAA may either uphold the District III Committee's ruling to deny eligibility or they may overturn the Committee's ruling and grant the student athletic eligibility.
