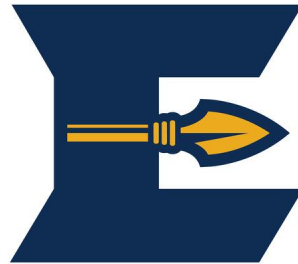

Data Analysis Summary

Fort Zeller ELA Linkit! Data

Year	BOY	EOY	% Increase	Grade Level
2022-2023	63.8%	79.9%	25.3%	K – 24.2% 1 – 28% 2 – 22%
2023-2024	58.5%	81.3%	39%	K – 41.1% 1 – 45.4% 2 – 28.5%

Fort Zeller Math Linkit! Data

Year	BOY	EOY	% Increase	Grade Level
2022-2023	63.4%	84.4%	33.7%	K – 31.2% 1 – 28.3% 2 – 43.2%
2023-2024	55.7%	86.2%	54.8%	K – 48.5% 1 – 49.5% 2 – 68.2%



Blueprint for Success: English Language Arts

By the end of the 2024-25 school year, each grade levels will show a 40% increase in their average score compared to the beginning of the year benchmark for the ELA Linkit Assessment.

Example: If a grade level's beginning of the year average score is 60%, they would need to get an average score of 84% by the end of the year. ($60 \times 0.40 = 24$ $60 + 24 = 84$.)

Action Plan

Tier 1:

- *Collaborative Teaching model/strategies will continue to be used to meet all students' needs.*
- *Students will use IXL to practice skills to proficiency based on diagnostic data and teacher assigned skills.*
- *Weekly Team Meetings – data driven meetings to address student needs.*
- *Grade Level Collaboration - two-hour delay and creative scheduling*

Tier 2:

- *Daily intensive interventions, with spiral reviews, drills, and interactive assignments, will be provided to students requiring additional support based on data. (UFLI, Foundations & IXL)*



Blueprint for Success: Mathematics

By the end of the 2024-25 school year, each grade level will show a 50% increase in their average score compared to the beginning of the year benchmark for the Math Linkit Assessment.

Example: If a grade level's beginning of the year average score is 60%, they would need to get an average score of 84% by the end of the year. ($60 \times 0.50 = 30$ $60 + 30 = 90$)

Action Plan

Tier 1:

- *Math lessons and assessments are aligned to the PA common core standards*
- *Grade Level Collaboration - two-hour delay and creative scheduling*
- *Weekly Team Meetings – data driven meetings to address student needs.*
- *Spring Math Intervention for all students.*
- *Students will use IXL to practice skills to proficiency based on diagnostic data and teacher assigned skills.*

Tier 2:

- *Daily intensive interventions will be provided to students requiring additional support (Small Groups, Spring Math & IXL) based on data.*



Blueprint for Success: School Climate/Culture

By the end of the 2024-25 school year, Fort Zeller will implement “Positive Outreach” during the 2024-2025 school year. Every teacher will make two positive phone calls and/or emails home to families each week throughout the school year.

Action Plan

All professional teaching staff will make two positive email/phone calls home each week.

- *This will help build strong, positive relationships with our families.*
- *Communication will be tracked using a google sheet.*
- *Every student will have at least one positive*
- *Documentation will be kept throughout the year*



Blueprint for Success: Readiness

By the end of the 2024-25 school year, through the implementation of 90 minutes of common planning time each month, each teacher will enhance learning opportunities for students by creating a minimum of four new technology lessons by the end of the year.

Action Plan

All classroom teachers will have 90 consecutive minutes of shared collaboration time with their grade level team each month.

- *Collaborate on planning.*
- *Implement technology to enhance learning.*
- *Review data to meet the needs of students.*



Points of Pride

- *Fort Zeller had a very successful four weeks of SPA, ELCO+, and ESY to help prepare our students for school starting in August.*
- *PBIS Program – Fort Zeller was just certified as a Tier 2 school at the end of the 2023-2024 school year.*
