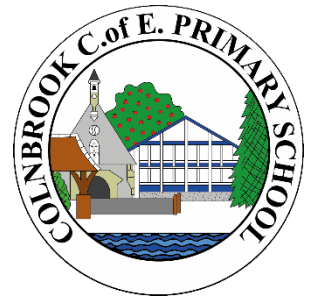

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to provide you a staffing update for our Year 4-6 classes.

Year 4

Unfortunately, Miss Lamba will be leaving Colnbrook at the end of this Autumn term, and we wish her all the best in her future endeavours.

We have appointed Mrs Barnard who will be the class teacher in Year 4 for the rest of the academic year, starting after Christmas on 6th January 2025. Mrs Barnard too is an experienced teacher who has taught across a range of age groups in several different school settings. We are looking forward to welcoming her in January!

Mrs Barnard will be in school next Thursday, on the 19th of December 2024, to get to know the Year 4 children and meet Year 4 parents at the end of the day in the hall at 3pm. We encourage Year 4 parents to come along and meet Mrs Barnard in person so that you can ask any questions that you may have.

Year 5

As you know, Miss Horan will be starting her maternity leave in April 2025.

We have now appointed a class teacher, Mr Symes, to cover Miss Horan's maternity leave for the rest of the academic year. Mr Symes is an experienced KS2 teacher, having taught in several different schools. We are looking forward to him joining our school community.

Year 5 parents will have the opportunity to meet Mr Symes before the Easter holidays; we will inform you of the exact date closer to the time.

Year 6

As you are aware, Mr Brunson is currently experiencing health difficulties. We look forward to him returning to school when he is fit and well. However, in the interim, I will be taking the role of Acting Headteacher in his current absence. As a result, Mrs Whiteman, who has been working closely with Year 6 in supporting their learning, will be teaching Year 6 on Mondays and Tuesdays in January. Mrs Uppal will continue to teach Year 6 from Wednesday to Friday. I appreciate that change is not always easy and changing teachers during the school year is not ideal. However, we are putting in place provisions to best support the children and ensure that disruption is kept to a minimum. We will work with the children to make this transition as smooth as possible and I appreciate your support in working with us to do this.
