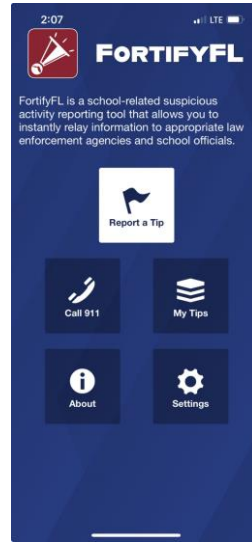

### **Important Notice:**

- It is important to understand that knowingly submitting a false tip through FortifyFL is a serious offense (a 3<sup>rd</sup> degree felony).

# **False Tips**

Making a threat on social media is when a person communicates a threat to kill, do great bodily injury, conduct a mass shooting or an act of terrorism.

Social media platforms that other people can view include:

- Direct messages or posting status updates on any social media platform
- Snapchat stories or messages
- Video platforms such as YouTube or TikTok
- Gaming servers or chats such as Discord, Steam, or Twitch
- Anonymous chat rooms or posting sites such as Whisper and AskFM

# Making a Threat on Social Media



# What happens if a student makes a threat on social media?

Merely communicating a threat on social media is enough to warrant a felony charge, whether there is actual intent or ability to carry out the threat or not.

A person communicating a threat to kill, do great bodily harm, conduct a mass shooting or an act of terrorism in any way that another person can view it is committing a second-degree felony under section 863.10, Florida Statute

Other consequences a student could

School expulsion for a year

Placement in an alternative school

Inability to graduate or attend school events with friends

Paying restitution costs for the law enforcement investigation

Criminal charge

# You Should Know:

There is an anonymous reporting app that allows you to instantly send information about suspicious activity.



# Remember...



All threats will be taken seriously and will result in severe consequences up to and including arrest, restitution, and expulsion. Parents are urged to discuss this information with their child.



False threats, even if intended as just a joke, can result in life changing consequences.

With *FortifyFL*, you can submit tips about **potential crimes or threats** which are sent directly to law enforcement and designated school personnel.

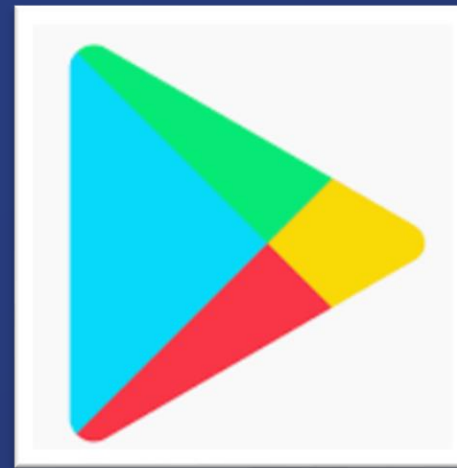

# How do I submit a tip?

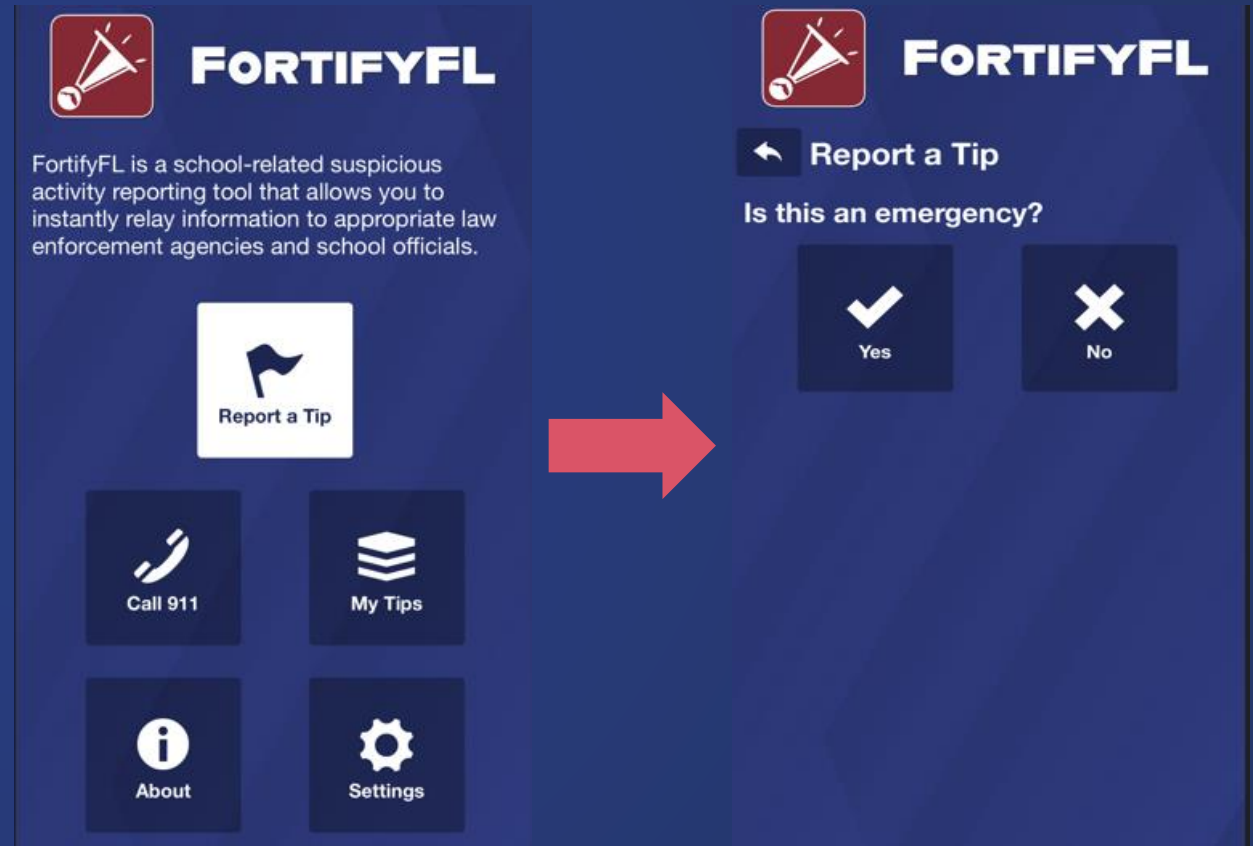
Tips must have **actionable** information.

This means including **WHO** did **WHAT**,  
**WHERE** it happened and **WHEN**.

More tip details improve the chances  
that a situation can be resolved.

## Important Notice:

Per Florida law if someone **knowingly submitted a false tip** through FortifyFL, device information will be provided to law enforcement, and the individual could be subject to criminal penalties.



### Important Notice

Florida Statute 943.082 states that if, following an investigation, it is determined that a person knowingly submitted a false tip through FortifyFL, the Internet protocol (IP) address of the device on which the tip was submitted will be provided to law enforcement agencies for further investigation, and the reporting party may be subject to criminal penalties under s. 837.05. In all other circumstances, unless the reporting party has chosen to disclose his or her identity, the report will remain anonymous.
