READING: In Unit 4, students will read and compare texts with different types of characters and settings to understand how authors create stories. In Unit 5, students will read and compare texts about inventors and their inventions to understand how technology is made and how it works.

MATH: Students will use a number line to add and subtract by 5s and 10s. Students will also begin measuring and comparing using various objects.

SOCIAL STUDIES: We will learn to draw and interpret maps, use location words to describe where places and things are located, and compare natural and human-made characteristics.
