The FRC room is for the families to visit anytime. I am here for you!! We offer various services and have many reference materials in the room for you to take.

Some of the services we provide are:

- School Readiness Pre-K classrooms for children 3-5 years old at Mahan, Veterans, Moriarty, Uncas, and Huntington
- Ask about our Family Literacy/ ELL class with Adult Ed. They provide a light dinner and childcare.
- Support and training for Home Daycare Providers
- Morning coffee chats in the FRC office and on Zoom at 10:00 once a month (last Thursday of each month)
- Parents as Teachers program (PAT) is an educational program that provides developmental information and support to families with children under three years old.
- Playgroups once a week at Mohegan Commons Learning Center
- Parenting workshops (COS), Raising Readers, and monthly support groups for single parents and grandparents raising grandchildren
- Clothing swaps and toy drives
- Community resources are available in the FRC room for you to look through or take. These include Care 4 Kids, the Tommy Toy Fund, Thanksgiving Baskets, and much more. There are computers for families to use.
- Monthly community partners are available for easy sign-ups, housing assistance, SNAP, heating assistance, lead testing, and much more.
- Monthly family nights
- PTO monthly meetings
- Help with attendance
- Computers for parents to use
- Support for families during PPT meetings
- Home Visits
