Over 43 languages other than English are spoken by Alameda High students. These include Cantonese, Mandarin, Tagalog, Spanish, Vietnamese, Mongolian, Arabic, Punjabi, Bosnian, Portuguese, French, Italian, Farsi, Indonesian, and Thai.

**Starting in 2024-25, Alameda Unified School District implemented a new more equitable grading policy. Under the Assessing Students Accurately grading for equity policy the range for a failing grade is no longer 0-59% but 50-59%.**

Only grades that are passing (“D” or above) are used to award credits towards graduation.

**GPA:** Grading scale for calculating GPA: A= 4, B= 3, C= 2, D=1, F=0. Advanced Placement and honors courses are weighted on a 5.0 scale (A=5, B=4, C=3).

**Alameda High does not rank students.**

**Community Service:** Students have a 20-hour community service requirement to graduate.

**Alameda High adopted the Integrated Math model in 2024-25.**

**Students are limited to four AP/Honors classes each year. Limited students may take an additional AP/Honors class with special approval by the principal. Students are allowed one math and one science class per year. Students interested in additional coursework in those areas are entered in a lottery pending space availability.**
