### Ruppel Academie Francaise-Auto Admissions into ASA

#### High School Acceptance Policy:

In accordance with the district's 2020 Infrastructure and Efficiency Plan, we will provide the opportunity for Ruppel Academie Francaise students to matriculate into an ASA high school. For their 9th grade year, students will be granted automatic admission into an ASA if they have earned a 2.0 GPA and score a combination of Mastery/Advanced in ELA and Math on their 7th grade LEAP 2025. If a student does not achieve the GPA and required scores during their 7th grade year, they will be allowed to use their GPA and assessment scores during their 8th grade year. Students fulfilling the auto-admissions criteria during their 8th grade year, are subject to capacity at the ASA High School. Students must fulfill the requirements for promotion and academic requirements as stated in the academic dismissal procedure.

- 8th grade students will be individually reviewed to assess their eligibility for admission to an ASA high school.
- The review will include the student's **7th grade LEAP scores** and **7th grade final report card**.
- Automatic admission into an ASA high school will be granted only if all of the following criteria are met:

#### 7th Grade

- The student must have a final GPA of 2.0 in the 7th grade year and must complete the 8th grade year in good standing.
- The student must achieve **Mastery/Advanced** levels in both **ELA** and **Math** on the LEAP assessment (a minimum of mastery in each subject is required).
- If the student does not meet the GPA and LEAP requirements during their 7th grade year, they may use their **8th grade GPA** and **LEAP** scores for eligibility.

#### 8th Grade

- Students who meet the automatic admission criteria during their 8th grade year will be subject to availability at the ASA High School.
- These students will go through the transfer process before newly admitted students to the Advanced Study Academies.
- Students who do not meet the GPA or assessment requirements for transfer to an ASA can apply for admission to the International Baccalaureate Magnet program, provided their cumulative GPA at the end of the 8th grade is at least 2.0.

**Scenario 1:** In 7th grade the student earns a Mastery or higher in both ELA and Math. The student has also earned a 2.0 in all subjects attempted excluding physical education and health. The student **would** be granted automatic admission into an ASA high school for their 9th grade year.

**Scenario 2:** In 7th grade, the student LEAP scores show that they earned less than Mastery on either ELA or Math but earns Mastery on the other. The student has an end of year GPA of 2.0 or higher. The student **would not** be granted automatic admission into an ASA for high school based on their 7th grade scores. In 8th grade, the student scores mastery or above in ELA and Math and has a final 8th grade GPA of 2.0 or higher. The student **then would** be granted auto-admissions subject to capacity at the ASA high school.

**Scenario 3:** In 7th grade the student earns a Mastery or higher in both ELA and Math. The student also earns a 2.0 in all subjects attempted excluding physical education and health at the end of the 7th grade year. In 8th grade the student's final GPA in all subjects excluding physical education is less than a 2.0. The student would not be eligible for transfer into an ASA high school and **would not** be eligible to apply for the International Baccalaureate Program.
