
Fall 2024 Final Exam Schedule 12/16- 12/20

Attendance Correction Slip (Oops Slip)

If a student believes they were incorrectly marked absent, they should visit the attendance desk in the front office to obtain an **"Attendance Correction Slip."** The student must then present the slip to their teacher for verification and a signature. Once signed, the slip should be returned to the attendance desk, where the record will be updated accordingly. Students are encouraged to take responsibility for ensuring the accuracy of their attendance.

Please note that attendance updates may take up to 48 hours, as staff review each case in the order in which calls and requests are received.


