FHS and SHMS Libraries proudly present **\*One Community, One Book\***!



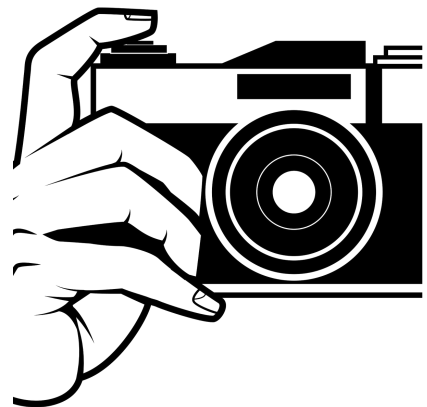
