**Policy Statement #3900 (Students) of the Board of Education
Regarding School Health Services**

I. Purpose

- A. To establish guidelines for the provision of health care in the school setting as outlined under existing federal, state, and local laws and regulations and other school system policies.

II. Policy Statement

- A. The Board of Education recognizes the relationship between student health and student academic achievement. Optimal health and safety is the shared responsibility of the individual, the family, and the school system. The Board affirms its intention to provide school health services in compliance with statutory and regulatory mandates for students with the primary goal of supporting students' participation in the educational process.

III. Delegation

- A. The Superintendent is directed to develop administrative procedures to implement this policy in accordance with all local policies and local, state and federal laws and regulations and to communicate this policy and accompanying procedures to all relevant parties.

IV. Exceptions

- A. There are no exceptions to this policy. However, the Board, by majority vote, may temporarily suspend all or part of this policy. Suspension of all or part of this policy, however, in no way relieves the Board of its obligation to comply with the pertinent local, state and federal laws and regulations or the rules and regulations of the Maryland State Board of Education and the Maryland State Department of Education.

V. Review

- A. This policy will be reviewed at the end of three years, or sooner, if approved by majority vote of the Board of Education in public session.

VI. Effective Date

- A. This policy is effective December 12, 2024.
