## **Reviewing Your Course Plan**

- Login to Class Link
- Click on the Xello app
- Review your course selections and make any adjustments for the next school year
- Make sure that you are selecting courses that align with your future goals.

## Helpful Hints for Choosing Core Classes:

- You will need to choose English, Math, Science, and History for next year
- · You decide which level you want to take
  - On-Level
  - Advanced
  - AP
  - TCC

Your counselor will help you determine the correct course when they review your plan.

## Helpful Hints for Choosing Electives:

- You are required to take the following elective requirements:
  - Fine Arts (1 year)
  - Foreign Language (same language for 2 years)
  - P.E. (2 semesters)

If you have not yet taken these required electives, I would advise that you select them for the next school year.

#### Ben Barber Electives

- When selecting electives at Ben Barber, you must select two 18 week courses or one 36 week course.
- Please review the course description guide for prerequisite requirements.
- You need to choose a Ben Barber course for each semester.

#### **Courses Requiring Tryout or Application**

- We will not enroll any student in the following courses because they require approval or a try-out. You will list any of these courses as an alternate choice and you will be put in them if approved.
  - Cheerleading
  - Drill Team
  - AVID (if not already in the program)

#### **Alternates**

- It is very important to choose alternate courses.
- Please list at least 4 alternate courses that you would be okay taking.
- If you choose Ben Barber electives, make sure you list Ben Barber electives in your alternate choices.
- Remember if you do not list any alternates, your counselor will choose them for you!!!

#### Late Arrival & Senior Release

- Remember in order to have a release block, you must meet the following qualifications:
  - Earned your CCMR Point
  - Passed or Exempted all of your required EOC exams
  - No Absence Fails
- CCMR points are earned in the following ways and your counselor will be reviewing this information with you at registration.
  - Passed the TSI for both ELA & Math
  - Earned 3 hours in an English or Math Dual Credit Course or 9 hours in additional dual credit courses
  - Earned a High Enough Score on either the SAT or ACT
  - Earn a 3 or higher on an AP exam
  - Be a Completer and Earned an IBC through your Ben Barber courses
  - Enlist with the military and complete the DD-4 Form

### **Important Reminders**

- In April, all students and parents will receive an email with instructions on how to view your course requests and the process to make any changes.
- When you receive this email, please follow the instructions and submit any changes by the deadline (mid-April).
- After this April deadline, students will not be able to make changes to their elective courses, so it is
  very important that you take time at registration selecting your electives.
- At registration you will be asked to select alternates in the event that your first choice does not work.
- If you do not select any alternates, then you will be scheduled into whatever elective has room if your first choice does not work.
- Please note that when schedules are made available in August, you will not be able to make changes to your electives. You will only be able to make changes to your core classes.
- This change will be new next year, so please make sure that you are putting some thought into your elective choices!!
