
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO!



On rare occasions, it may be necessary to close District 65 schools and centers due to extreme temperatures, inclement weather, or other emergency situations. It's important to understand what happens when school is closed, before you go!

E-LEARNING OR SNOW DAYS?

It's important for staff and families to know what to expect! District 65 will use the following cadence for using E-Learning or Snow Days.* This pattern will restart when a new school year begins.





*Please note: This is subject to change if conditions don't allow for E-Learning (eg widespread power outage).

Counts as an Instructional Day

Synchronous learning (or live instruction)

Extends the school year beyond the last scheduled day

Schools are closed for in-person instruction

Student lunches are offered

Digital Learning Platforms Available (asynchronous)



5 AM

Decisions will be made as early as possible, possibly the night before depending on the forecast, but no later

than 5am the day of the closure.
