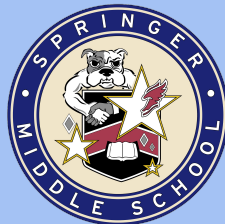
Our Building Mission & Vision

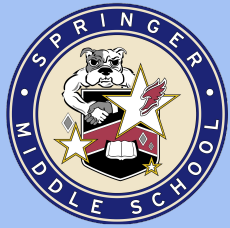
Mission Statement:

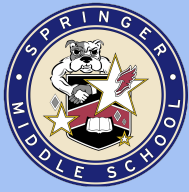


LEARNING AT Springer Middle School **Honors & Accelerated Courses**

- Springer Middle School also offers Fast Math, which is our most advanced math and progresses students through almost two years of math in one school year





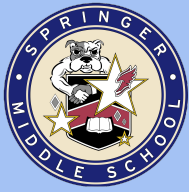

- The AVID curriculum, based on rigorous standards, is driven by the WICOR method, which stands for Writing, Inquiry, Collaboration, Organization, and Reading.





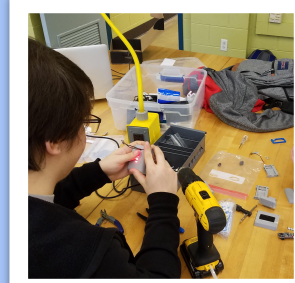

LEARNING AT Springer Middle School **BARK Summer Camp**

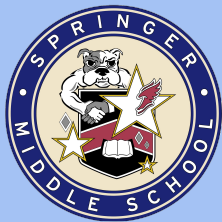
Bark Summer Camp
