I. QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

The following questions are as they were presented to Park Hill School District. The answers to said questions have been answered as completely and accurately as possible.

Q1: Software Code on switches varies from the Universal image and the Non-Payload Encrypted (NPE) image. Normally we see the Universal image across the board. Would Park Hill like for us to standardize on one version of the image? If so, which one?

- a. Builds 1, 6, 8, and 9 use the Universal Image
- b. Builds 2, 5, and 10 use the NPE Image

A1: Please see attached updated cost worksheet, each builds 2, 5, and 10 should now reflect using the Universal Image.

Q2: Build 9 uses the 2XL supervisor while all other Chassis builds use the standard 2-B supervisor. Is this intended or should all supervisors across all chassis be the same?

A2: Please see attached updated cost worksheet, build 10 should now reflect using the standard 2-B supervisor.

Q3: Cost Sheets:

If we are providing only an "equivalent" to the requested Cisco. How do you want us to show that on the Cost Sheets Provided?

A3: Please utilize the alternate bid tab to provide alternate makes and part numbers.

Q4: Cisco SmartNet:

If we are not providing a Cisco SmartNet response. Do you want us to simply not include the SmartNet RFP and Cost Sheet? I ask as they are part of the overall 470/Attachments.



A4: They can be separate.

Q5: AP Installation:

Are there locations that will require a Lift? If so, does the school have Lift's available to be used?

A5: External AP installation assistance is not required.

Q6: Cables:

Clarification, the only Cables requested are for Stacking/Connecting Switches, no other Copper/Fiber is requested?

A6: That is correct.

Q7: Phones:

Cisco Phones are listed which of course are not E-Rate Eligible. Will you award the Networking Equipment separately from the Phones listed?

A7: Per Section III, item E. of the RFB: The District reserves the right to award this contract in its entirety or to split the contract between bidders, whichever is in the best interest of the District. The District may accept any item or group of items of the bid unless qualified by specific limitation of the bidder.

Q8: Ineligible Licensing:

Thousand Eyes, etc. Since these are ineligible anyway, can we assume that you'll award these outside of the Network E-Rate responses?

A8: Per Section III, item E. of the RFB: The District reserves the right to award this contract in its entirety or to split the contract between bidders, whichever is in the best interest of the District. The District may accept any item or group of items of the bid unless qualified by specific limitation of the bidder.

Q9: Wireless:

Wi-Fi 7 has been ratified, are you interested in seeing a response for those AP's?

A9: Not at this time.



Q10: Core Switches:

What's the max uplink needed?

A10: 10Gb.

Q11: AP Count:

470 lists Access Points at qty (474), the Cost sheet show qty (43) Build4. Are the balance of the AP's requested for Cisco SmartNet Licensing ONLY?

A11: Please use the quantity on the cost worksheet.
