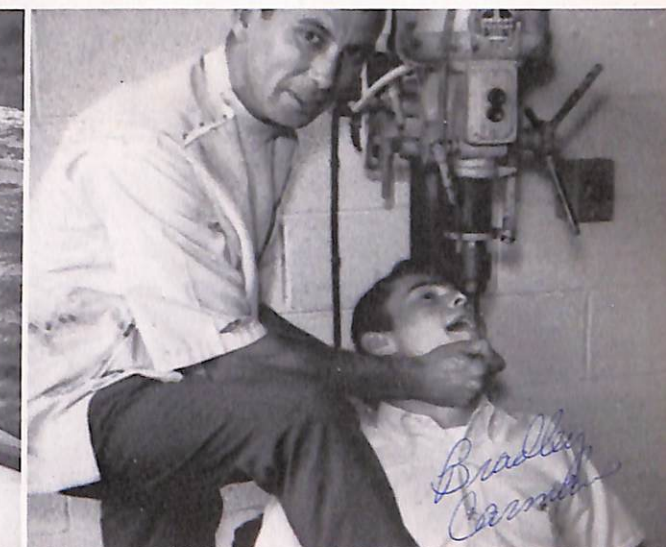
## Dedication
