## SGT. BRADLEY J. HARPER MEMORIAL HIGHWAY

Dresden Elementary staff and students were invited to the community event held on September 4th at the Dresden Cemetery honoring Sergeant Bradley J. Harper and the naming of a section of highway 60 in his name. The two-mile section of Route 60 from its intersection with Main Street in Dresden, Ohio to its connection with Route 16 is now officially named in honor of Sgt. Harper, who sacrificed his life while serving in Iraq. Sgt. Harper was born in Zanesville, Ohio and enlisted in the US Marine Corps Reserves on July 27, 1998. He was killed in action Wednesday, August 3, 2005 during a combat operation in southern Iraq. Students and staff walked over to the cemetery and participated in the ceremony. Students, Sophia Mancuso and Piper Clifford led the Pledge of Allegiance.



## BEHAVIOR REWARD



Adamsville Elementary implemented a new behavior reward system called Positive Action Ticket (PAT) and it encompasses the 3Be's;

1. Be kind and respectful
2. Be ready and responsible
3. Be a problem solver and do your best

Students may earn this two part ticket for their 3Be behavior from any staff member, including bus drivers. One half of the ticket enters a drawing for classroom rewards and the other ticket half is placed in a tub in the cafeteria that Mr. Brillhart draws from for recognition over the loudspeaker. All tickets are posted on a board in the cafeteria. At the end of the grading period, Mr. Brillhart asked teachers to name 1 large item winner and 2 small item winners from their room for prizes such as candy, skateboards, playground balls, board games, and craft items. Students that exhibited 3Be behavior during the grading period, whether recognized on a ticket or not, received a reward of an extra recess with planned activities like the parachute, tug-of-war and fun blacktop games.

## BUS SAFETY

Students have bus safety training annually at the beginning of each school year. The training teaches safety measures to ensure students understand proper bus safety rules including how to properly sit on a bus with hands inside windows, entering and exiting a bus safely, danger zones, driver hand signals, emergency evacuation of a bus, etc. It is important that students exercise these trainings to ensure

### CHILD FIND - A SEARCH FOR ALL CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

Every school district has the responsibility of seeking out and identifying children in need of special education services. Although school-age children are identified through each building's intervention assistance team and referral process, parents of children not yet enrolled, who reside within the Tri-Valley Local Schools boundaries, may not be aware that services are available.

#### What does a disability mean:

For ages birth to 3: an established condition known to result in delay or a developmental delay.

For ages 3-5: a documented deficit in one or more of the following developmental areas:

communication	vision
hearing	motor skills
self-help skills	cognitive skills
social/emotional/behavioral functioning	

For ages 5-21: identification of one or more of the following conditions

- autism
- hearing impairment including deafness
- Intellectual disability
- multiple disabilities
- orthopedic impairment
- other health impairment
- emotional disturbance
- specific learning disabilities
- speech or language impairment
- traumatic brain injury
- visual impairment including blindness
