STOPit Anonymous Reporting System

School Town of Munster uses STOPit, an online and app-based system, to empower students, parents, teachers and others to anonymously report anything of concern to school officials - from cyberbullying to threats of violence or self-harm.

Each School Town of Munster website includes a call-to-action button on its homepage that will link you to the STOPit app.

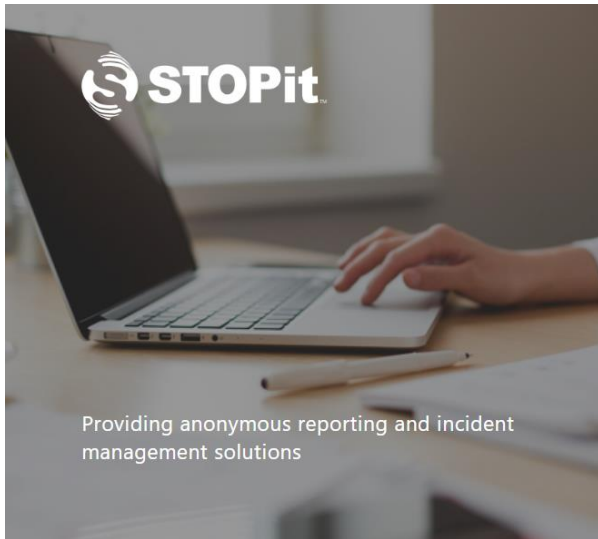

PLEASE NOTE:
All reports are anonymous.

- Reports are instantly received by assigned school administrators and SROs, who will then take appropriate actions. One benefit of the STOPit app is that it allows for two-way communication. School administrators and SROs have the ability to confirm to the student that the report has been received and ask any necessary follow-up questions.
- Students can also access the **Get Help icon**, which gives them access to local resources such as law enforcement, mental health centers, crisis hotlines and additional resources.
- The STOPit site/mobile app is available to students 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Parents and teachers can use the STOPit app to make a report.
