<p>Ofsted have stated that "We will not always know the learning outcomes" so segregated learning objectives at the start of each lesson are not appropriate.</p> <p>The strands of Charanga's musical learning, presented within the lesson plans and the on-screen resources, are part of the learning spiral.</p> <p>Within each half-termly unit, children develop new musical skills and concepts, but also revisit established musical skills and concepts.
