

Mrs. Trombly's Humanities class at Churchill High School brought a Greek Orders architecture lesson to life by creating sculptures with Play-Doh!




Kindergarteners at Niji-Iro Elementary had fun practicing their letters with shaving cream!








Coolidge Elementary first graders did a great job practicing their math with grid puzzles in Mrs. Shocker's class! Great job, first graders!
