- Paws For A Cause hosted two fundraisers in December to support families in need. These events enabled the six schools to purchase gifts for 172 children.
 - The Beach Haven West Community Group donated over 60 toys and \$2500 for our families in need.
- Barnegat Pride donated \$750, bicycles, and toys to support our families in need.
 - The Barnegat Rotary Elf Program sponsored 45 children. The BHS Interact Club assisted the Rotarians with shopping for gifts at Target.

- Barnegat PBA 296 held its Annual Toy Drive. Officers collected toys from local businesses and Elfie's House. Toys were delivered and sorted for distribution to the individual schools. The PBA also donated \$2,000 to Paws For A Cause.
- Ten children from the Donahue School participated in "Shop with a Cop" at Walmart in Little Egg Harbor. Barnegat Police officers were on hand to assist the children while they shopped.
 - Pheasant Run community members sponsored 29 children.
